- *Biggest of this kind*







Objectives


- *To develop EU harmonised methodology*

- *EU database and samples*
- *To improve capacity of veterinary services*

Overwintering colony mortality (winter 2012 – 2013; winter 2013 – 2014)




Seasonal colony mortality (spring-summer 2012 – 2013; spring-summer 2013 – 2014)



Seasonal Mortality Rate

- <5%
- 5-10%
- 10-20%
- >20%

- < 5%
- 5-10%
- 10-20%
- > 20%



Conclusions on mortalities

- *Narrower range in 2nd year*
- *Decrease*
- *Regional and temporal differences*
 - **Local!**
- *Weather*
- *Interpret with caution*
- *Statistical analysis: EFSA+EURL*

 - **Different methodology, list of pesticides, lab capacity, expertise, length, costs**





Calabria: surveillance in 2015




Sicily: surveillance in 2015 (source: IZSV)





EFSA on SHB: diagnosis and best practices

- *Technical assistance*
 - **Eradication rigorously and immediately**
 - (Later: all available methods)
 - **Feasible and effective to conduct surveillance**
 - **Standardisation of diagnosis**
 - **Visual inspection + traps**
 - **Education and awareness (beekeepers and officials)**
- *Scientific opinion*
 - **End of 2015**



Role of the beekeepers

- *Compulsory notification*
- *Inform vet services about suspicion*
- *Compliance with rules*
 - **Eradication**
 - **Transhumance**
 - **Trade of colonies out**
 - **Queen production**
- *Best practices*
- *Agreements among themselves*
