

MONITORING EU AGRI-FOOD TRADE

DEVELOPMENTS IN JUNE 2022 Publication: September 2022



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Note to the reader

The latest available consolidated trade data at EU level cover market developments until June 2022. Monthly figure figures can be compared with the previous month. Year-to-year change compares the cumulative trade since the beginning of the year with the same period in the previous year.

The trade figures are expressed in values, except when specifically mentioned. The unit value is the average price of products traded in the period concerned (trade value at the border divided by quantity registered).

HIGHLIGHTS: MONTHLY DATA FOR JUNE 2022 SHOW AN INCREASED TRADE BALANCE

EU exports in June remained elevated but imports slowed down. This resulted in an improved **trade balance at EUR 5.1 billion**, which is a significant increase compared to the previous month of May (+33%).

EU **exports** stayed high at **EUR 19.5 billion**. This is a small increase compared to May (+1%), but still 19.5% higher compared to June last year. Exports to sub-saharan Africa increased the most month-to-month (+EUR 121 million) which is due not only to a price effect but also increased volumes of commodities (notably wheat) to the continent.

EU **imports** reached **EUR 14.5 billion** in June 2022, a -7% decrease compared to the previous month, but still a +31% increase compared to June 2021. This monthly decrease is notably due to a decrease in EU monthly imports from Brazil and the US, which are still well above the imports of June 2021.

EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS

INCREASE IN EU EXPORTED VOLUMES IN JUNE BOOSTED TOTAL VALUE OF EXPORTS

In June 2022, EU agri-food exports increased by 1% month-to-month, to reach EUR 19.5 billion. Even though international commodity prices remained at historical heights back in June, they slightly decreased compared to the previous month of May. This is particularly the case for cereals, dairy products and oilseeds for which quantity exported increased while prices decreased month-to-month.

EU agri-food exports to **sub-saharan Africa** continued to increase in June. Particularly, EU exported volumes of cereals in June were 80% higher compared to the last three-year average (June 2019, June 2020 and June 2021). This is due, in particular, to an increase in EU wheat exported volumes, +82%.

EU exports to **Ukraine** were 25% higher in June compared to June 2021 and reached EUR 275 million. Notably, EU vegetables and pigmeat exports to Ukraine continued to be the most dynamic in June. Export volumes in June were 557% and 112% higher than last year.

Trade developments in January-June 2022

EU exports have been increasing the most to the UK, the US and Morocco during the first semester (S1) 2022 compared to S1 2021.

EU exports to **Morocco** increased by 57% in the period (+EUR 728 million) while exports to the whole **MENA region** has increased substantially. This is also due to an increase in quantity exported of, among others, cereals (+1 million tons exported

compared to S1 2021, half of which being wheat), sunflower seeds (+135%), fruits and nuts (+11%) and vegetables (+29%).


EU exports to **the UK** were 19% higher in the S1 2022 compared to 2021. This was led by a sharp increase in cereals preparations (+23%, +EUR 478 million year-to-year), mostly due to an increase in the unit import price (+14%) but also volume increase (+8%).

EU exports to **China** are still on the low levels with a 27% decrease year-to-year.

MORE WHEAT, SUNFLOWER AND FRESH DAIRY PRODUCTS EXPORTED IN JUNE

In June 2022, the EU exported more volumes compared to May 2022. Indeed, consolidated data show that the EU exported +16% more cereals than in May (+74% compared to June 2021). Wheat exported volumes increased by 7% and were also 137% higher than exports in June 2021. Exports of oilseeds and protein crops were also 13% higher (still in volumes) than in May and 49% higher than in June 2021. This was not the case for soya beans and rapeseed for which exported volumes decreased while unit value in the international market continued to rise.

For animal products, EU exports of beef and veal, **dairy** and sheep and goat exports increased. Exports of **poultry** slightly declined. Except for sheep and goat, unit export value for the other animal products dropped compared to May 2022.



EU AGRI-FOOD IMPORTS

LESS QUANTITY IMPORTED IN JUNE LED TO A SLIGHT DECLINE OF EU IMPORT BILL

After the peak in EU imports in May, imports declined in June to EUR 14.5 billion (-7%). Imports from Brazil, the US and Indonesia decreased month-to-month. At the same time, EU imports from Ukraine increased substantially (+EUR 218 million, +33%).

EU imports from **Brazil** decreased by 21% in June compared to May, mainly due to less imported volumes. The EU imported significantly less cereals (-60% month-to-month) and oilseeds (-31%) which resulted in a decrease of the import bill of EUR 58 million and EUR 390 million respectively. On the contrary, EU imports increased for beef and poultry (both a volume and price effect).

Following the implementation of the Solidarity Lanes in May and the temporary trade liberalisation in June, EU agri-food imports from **Ukraine** increased in the month of June. This was particularly the case for oilseeds (+EUR 92 million) and oils (+EUR 90 million). Imports of poultry was the third biggest increase (+EUR 17 million), followed by cereals (+EUR 11 million). For these products, this was mainly a quantity-driven increase.

Trade developments in January-June 2022

Looking at the first semester of 2022, the EU has imported EUR 82 billion of agri-food products. It is EUR 19 billion above the first semester (S1) 2021, or 32%.


EU imports from **Brazil** have been 46% above last year. This is not only a consequence of high international commodity prices but also an increase in volumes imported from this country. This has been particularly the case for maize (+605 thousand tons compared to S1 2021), soya meals (+390 thousand tons). Raw sugar imports have also been on the rise (+101 thousand tons).

EU imports in S1 2022 increased as well from south-east Asia, particularly from Indonesia, Vietnam and Malaysia. Total EU imports from these three countries increased by 35% compared to S1 2021, an additional EUR 1.6 billion. This is mainly coming from imports of organic chemicals and coffee.

DECLINE IN IMPORTS OF OILSEEDS AND CEREALS INTO THE EU IN JUNE

In June 2022, the EU import bill decreased compared to May 2022 mainly thanks to a decline in **cereals** and **oilseeds** imports (-EUR 304 million and -EUR 442 million, respectively). **Fruit and vegetables** imports also declined (by -EUR 206 million). This is solely a quantity-driven effect.

Over the first semester 2022, EU imports increased across the board. This has been due, in particular, to the increase in international prices. The strongest increase has occurred in horticulture (+56% in import unit value), vegetable oils, as well as margarine, oils and fats (+51%).




FOCUS

Ukraine - EU trade flows until June 2022

During the first semester of 2022, the **EU agri-trade flows with Ukraine** increased by 36% compared to last year, to reach EUR 5.8 billion. The increase has been led by the rise in international prices but also the volumes traded between the EU and Ukraine.

EU imports from Ukraine increased by 61% in **first semester (S1) 2022**, compared to S1 last year. Total EU imports reached **EUR 4.4 billion**. The biggest increases have been coming from vegetable oils (+EUR 522 million), cereals (+497 million) and oilseeds and protein crops (+EUR 471 million). Despite the **rise in international commodity prices**, these increases in values have been accompanied by an **increase in volumes** as well. EU imported 942 thousand tons of vegetable oils (+23% compared to last year), 5.3 million tons of cereals (+19%) and 1.6 million tons of oilseeds (+34%).

In **June**, following the implementation of the EU solidarity lanes initiative in May and the temporary trade liberalisation early June, the most significant increase month-to-month was reported for **sunflower seeds** (+69% in value terms, +69% in volumes) and oilseeds (+50% in value, +48% in volumes). **Poultry imports** into the EU also rose in June month-to-month by 48% in value terms and +50% in volumes (and also 129% higher than the June average in the past three years).



EU exports to Ukraine **decreased** by 10% compared to semester 2021, in value terms. Total value of exports reached EUR 1.3 billion. Exports of sugar and isoglucose (-75% in value terms) and olives and olive oil (-60%) were the biggest decline. This had been mainly due to a reduction in volumes exported (respectively, -80% and -66%). The sector that has been also impacted is sheep and goat (-99% in both value and volume terms).
