





Distribution map of HPAI in Europe (Oct. 2020-May 2021)



Number of HPAI detections/week in 2020/2021 epidemic season




Number of HPAI detections/month in 2020/2021* epidemic season


Genetics of H5 HPAI viruses in EU

• Five identified serotypes:

- **H5N1**, **H5N3**, **H5N4**, **H5N5**, **H5N8**
- all in a **single group** within clade 2.3.4.4B
- cluster with HPAI H5 viruses detected in Kazakhstan and Russia since summer 2020

• Fifteen distinct genotypes (out of 17 detected in Europe, Russia and Kazakhstan) :

- six for **H5N8**, identified in **all countries**; includes **70% of the sequenced viruses**
- eight for **H5N5**
- one for **H5N1**
- one for **H5N3**
- one for **H5N4**



Comparison of HPAI 2016/2017 vs 2020-2021 epidemics in EU

	Number of countries affected	HPAI virus serotypes	Wild birds cases	Poultry outbreaks	Number of poultry affected in outbreaks
2016/2017*	22	H5N5, H5N6, H5N8	1563	1131	~ 9 mil.
2020/2021**	23	H5N1, H5N3, H5N4, H5N5, H5N8	2070	1166	~ 20 mil
