

Products that are consumed particularly frequently (e.g. apples, bananas, cucumbers, carrots) are also taken into account with the calculation with a higher proportion of the total basket. Expensive and sensitive types of fruit are rarely delivered and therefore play a lesser role in the price calculation. The portion price for apples was taken from the total calculation including logistics costs and is (random) EUR 0.39.
