| <b>Comments</b>          | <p>A total of EUR 35 531.45 was paid from national funds for the short-term delivery due to coronavirus in the week 4/2021 and for the only partial delivery to nurseries in the week 5/2021. The short-term closure due to the coronavirus outbreak and the resulting shortfalls in deliveries were declared as force majeure. EU aid: an amount of EUR 135 196.53 still to be declared/Aus Landesmitteln wurde eine Unterstützungszahlung in Höhe von insgesamt 35.531,45 € für die kurzfristig, durch Corona bedingte, ausgefallene Lieferung in der 4. KW 2021 und der nur teilweisen Belieferung der Kindertagesstätten in der 5. KW 2021 geleistet, die in der obigen Darstellung nicht aufgeführt ist. 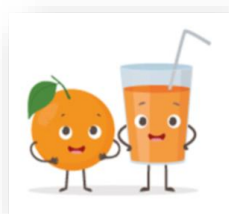
