Note to the reader

The latest available consolidated trade data at EU level cover market developments in September 2023. Monthly figures can be compared with the previous month. Year-on-year change compares the cumulative trade since the beginning of the year with the same period in the previous year.

The trade figures are expressed in values, except when specifically mentioned. The unit value is the average price of products traded in the period concerned (trade value at the border divided by quantity registered).

HIGHLIGHTS: EU agri-food trade surplus increases in September 2023

EU agri-food trade surplus reached +EUR 6.7 billion in September 2023, this is an 18% increase compared to the previous month as well as compared to September 2022. The cumulative trade balance (January to September 2023) reached EUR 51 billion. It is EUR 8.5 billion higher compared to the same period in 2022.

EU exports increased by 5% month-on-month at EUR 19 billion in September 2023. This remains 9% lower than in September 2022. Cumulative exports since January reached EUR 170.7 billion, 2% higher compared than in the same period in 2022. Main increases were for cereal preparations and preparations of fruit and nuts.

EU imports decreased by 2% month-on-month in September. They reached EUR 12.3 billion, 19% below their level of September 2022. Cumulative imports (from January to September 2023) reached EUR 119.7 billion, 5% below their 2022 level, with reductions in imports of oilseeds and protein crops as well as vegetable oils.

EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS

EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS INCREASE IN SEPTEMBER 2023

EU agri-food exports increased to EUR 19 billion in September 2023, a 5% increase monthon-month. However, they remain 9% below their September 2022 level. Cumulative exports from January to September 2023 reached EUR 170.7 billion, EUR 2.6 billion (+2%) higher than for the same period last year.

Cumulative EU agri-food exports to the **UK** increased significantly compared to 2022, with a growth of EUR 3 billion (+8%). This is explained particularly by an export increase of cereal preparations and milling products, preparations of fruit and nuts, confectionery and chocolate and pigmeat.

Türkiye is the other destination for which EU cumulative exports increased significantly in 2023 compared to 2022 (+EUR 836 million, +29%). However, these exports appear to be back at their 2022 level in August and September.

On the other hand, the largest reduction in EU exports was recorded for the **US**, with a decrease of EUR 1.9 billion (-8%). This is largely explained by a reduction in exports of spirits and liqueurs and wine and wine-based products.

Another significant reduction in EU exports has been recorded for exports to **Egypt** (-EUR 739 million, - 36%), mainly driven by a reduction of cereal exports.

PIGMEAT AND SPIRITS EXPORTS DECREASED IN 2023

Cumulative exports for **cereal preparations and milling products** saw the largest increase compared to 2022 (+EUR 1.4 billion, +8%), followed by those of **preparations of fruit and vegetables** (+EUR 1.3 billion, +17%) and **confectionary and chocolate** (+EUR 1 billion, +14%). However, these increases in value are solely explained by higher prices and the volumes exported of these products declined by 5 to 8%.

Conversely, **cereals** represented the largest reduction in export value compared to 2022 (-EUR 1.9 billion, -15%). However, this is explained by reduced export prices (-18% in unit value). EU export volumes actually increased by 3.5%, reaching 36 million tonnes from January to September.

Export values also decreased for **pigmeat** (-EUR 986 million, -10%), **spirits and liqueurs** (-EUR 555 million, -7%), and **wine and wine-based products** (-EUR 407 million, -3%). These reductions in exports are more significant in volume terms, with respectively -19%, -11% and -7%.

On the other hand, volumes exported increased by 28% for **vegetable oils** and 13% for **oilseeds and protein crops**. However, lower export prices lead to a decrease of export values for **vegetable oils** (-EUR 120 million, -4%) and a small increase for oilseed and protein crops (+EUR 38 million, +2%).

EU AGRI-FOOD IMPORTS

EU IMPORTS REMAIN BELOW 2022 LEVEL IN SEPTEMBER

The value of EU **agri-food imports was EUR 12.3 billion** in September, a 2% reduction compared to the previous month and 19% below their level in September 2022. Cumulative imports from January to September 2023 reached EUR 119.7 billion, a 5% reduction compared to the same period in 2022 (-EUR 5.9 billion).

Imports from **Ukraine** saw the largest increase from January to September compared to 2022 (+EUR 891 million, +11%), mostly due to higher cereal imports. However, EU imports from Ukraine are below their 2022 level since June and were nearly back at their 2021 level in September.

Imports from **Türkiye** grew by 18% compared to 2022 (+EUR 715 million), mostly due to increased imports of fruit and nuts, vegetables, cereals as well as olives and olive oil.

On the other hand, the three largest reductions in EU imports compared to 2022 were from **Brazil** (-EUR 1.9 billion, -13%, mostly in soya beans, coffee and maize), **Argentina** (-EUR 1.4, -27%, mostly soya meals) and **Australia** (-EUR 889 million, -29%, mostly rapeseed).

Imports also decreased from **China** by EUR 854 million (-12%), as well as from **Indonesia** (-EUR 555 million, -11%), mostly due to reduced imports in non-edible products in both cases.

LOWER IMPORTS OF OILSEEDS AND VEGETABLE OILS IN 2023

Import values reduced mostly for **oilseeds and protein crops** (-EUR 2.7 billion, -14%) and **vegetable oils** (-EUR 2.3 billion, -28%), due to reductions of both prices and volumes.

Other significant reductions in import values were observed for **non-edible products** (-EUR 1.4 billion, -16% mostly due to lower prices), **coffee, tea, cocoa and spices** (-EUR 997 million, -6%) and **margarine and other oils and fats** (-EUR 966 million, -24%, explained by lower prices while volumes increased by 7%).

On the other hand, **tobacco and tobacco products** cumulative imports (January to September) increased the most compared to 2022 (+EUR 951 million, +38%).

It was followed by a growth of **cereals** imports of EUR 818 million (+10%), despite lower import prices. In volumes, cumulative cereals imports reached 28 million tonnes from January to September, a 19% increase compared to 2022.

Sugar imports were also at a high level, with an increase of 91% in cumulative value (EUR 735 million) and 56% in volume compared to 2022. However, their monthly value is back below their 2022 level since August.


