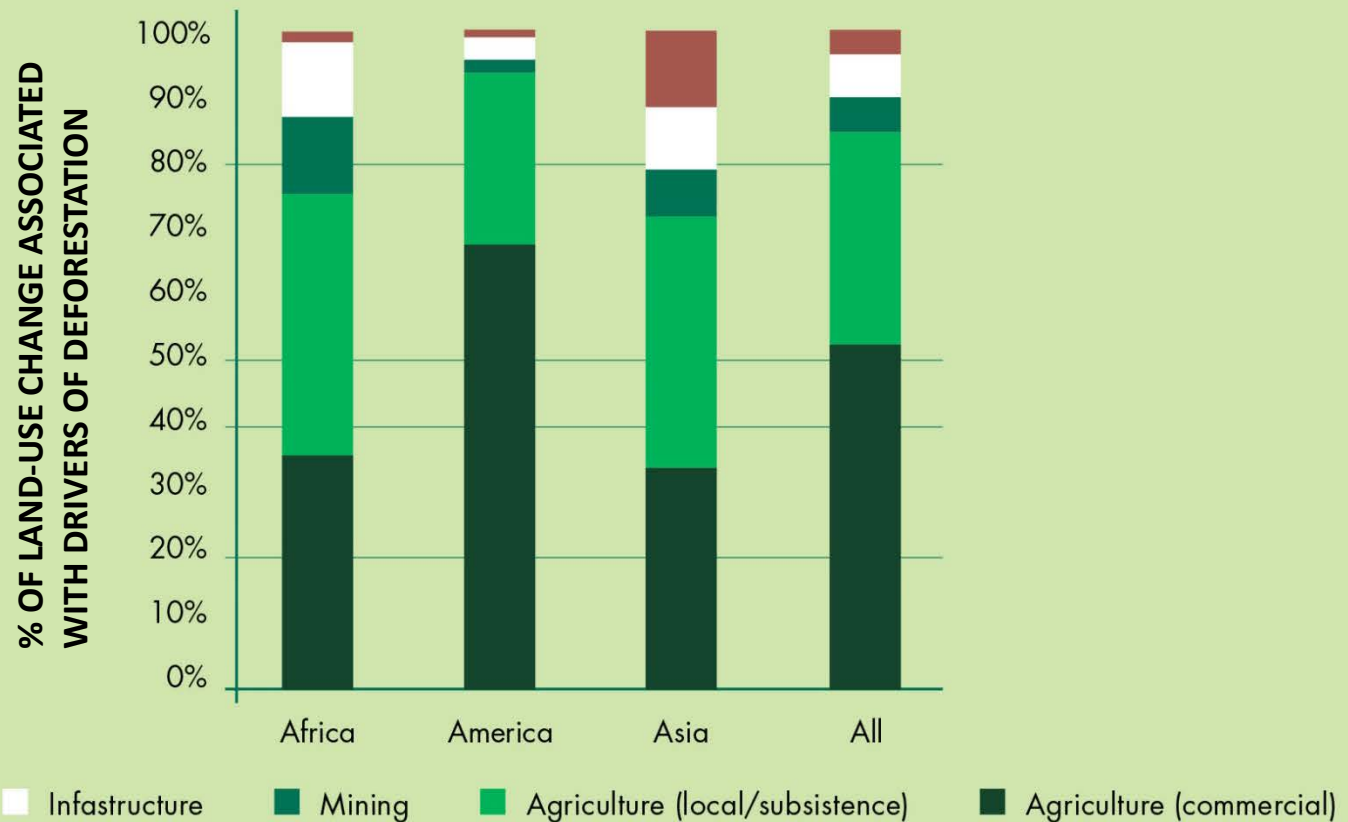

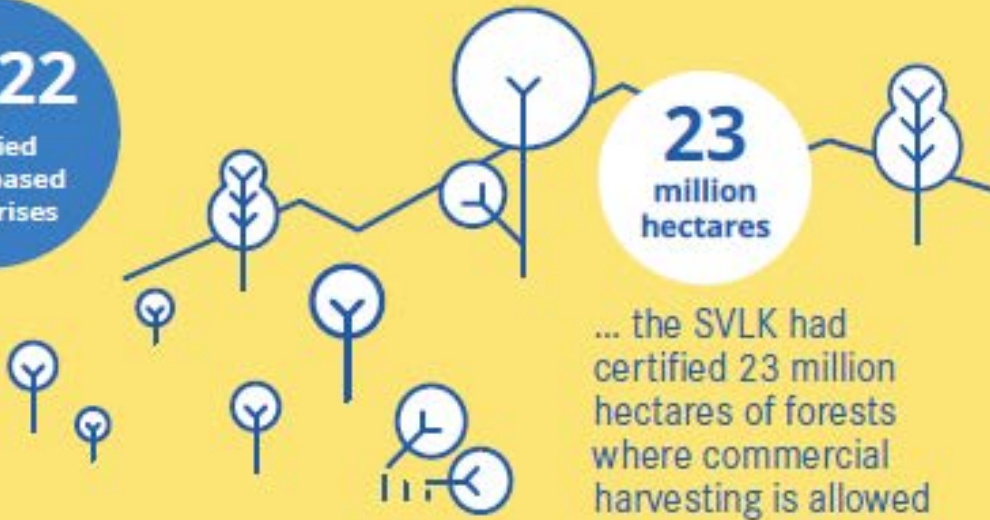
Indonesia – committed to addressing illegal logging

By 2018...



... the SVLK had certified 4,322 forest-based enterprises and industries, confirming that they comply with relevant laws and are part of the supply chain that can export FLEGT-licensed timber

... the SVLK had certified 23 million hectares of forests where commercial harvesting is allowed

Integrate smallholders' perspective

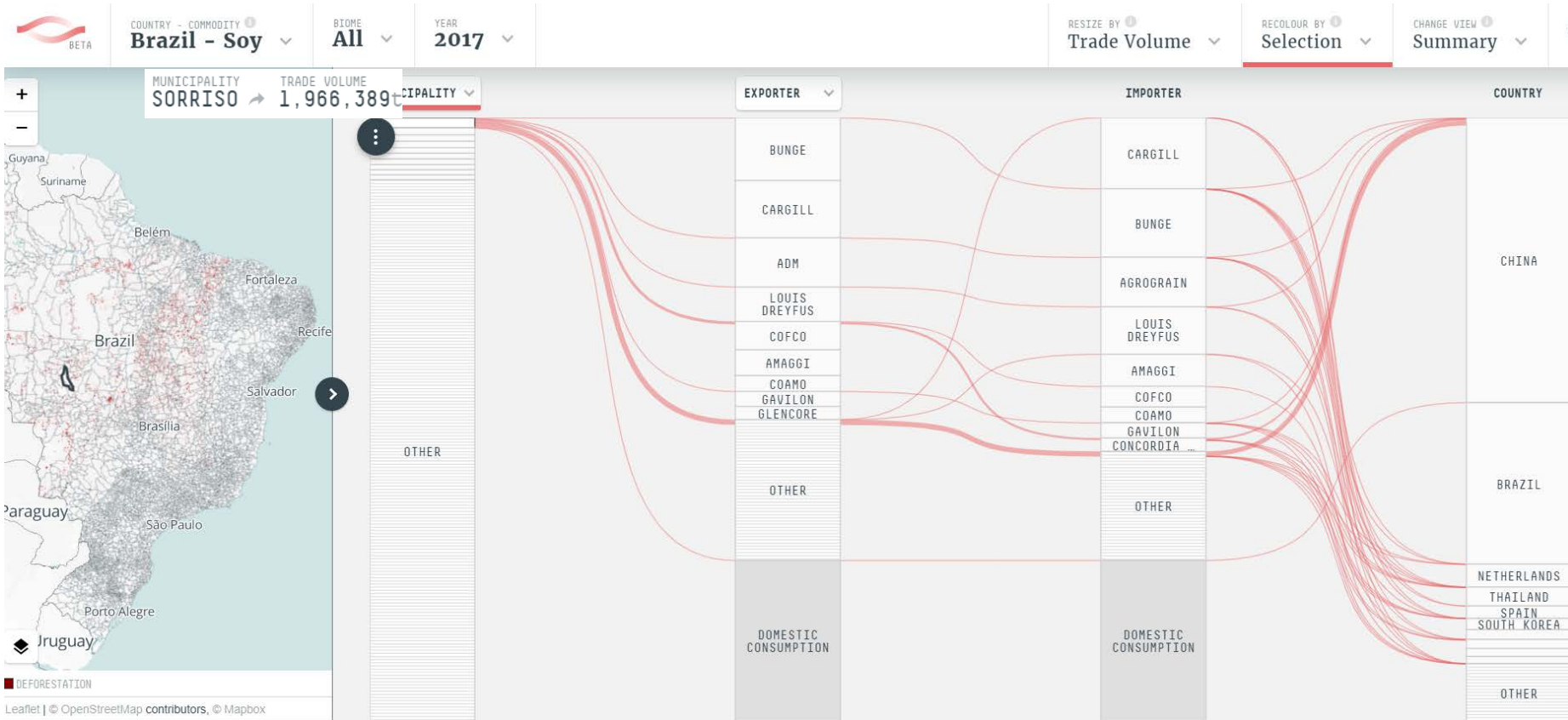


“I nearly lost my entire cocoa plantation, except for the areas where I had large trees. It was these trees' shade that saved the cocoa plants.”
