

MONITORING EU AGRI-FOOD TRADE

DEVELOPMENTS in April 2023 Publication: July 2023



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Note to the reader

The latest available consolidated trade data at EU level cover market developments in April 2023. Monthly figures can be compared with the previous month. Year-on-year change compares the cumulative trade since the beginning of the year with the same period in the previous year.

The trade figures are expressed in values, except when specifically mentioned. The unit value is the average price of products traded in the period concerned (trade value at the border divided by quantity registered).

HIGHLIGHTS: EU agri-food trade slows down in April 2023 compared to April 2022.

After a dynamic month of March, EU agri-food trade slowed down in April 2023, with a decrease of both imports and exports. EU agri-food surplus reached +EUR 4.8 billion in April, a 30% reduction month-on-month. This slide was due to a larger decrease in exports than in imports.

EU exports decreased to EUR 17.8 billion in April 2023, a 17% decrease compared to March 2023 and back at the same level than in April 2022, due to the decrease of export volumes across all products categories, while export unit values remained high. Cumulative exports (January to April 2023) reached EUR 76.1 billion (+10% compared to the same period in 2022), in particular for cereal preparations and preparations of fruit and nuts.

EU imports decreased as well in April 2023 by 11% month-on-month and reached EUR 13 billion, 4% below their level in April 2022. Contrary to exports, this decrease of the value of EU imports is mostly the result of a downward trend in imports prices in the last few months, while volumes only fell in April. Cumulative imports over the beginning of 2023 remained 7% higher compared to the same period in 2022.

EU AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS

AFTER A RECORD MONTH OF MARCH, EU EXPORTS DECREASED IN APRIL

EU agri-food exports decreased significantly in April and reached EUR 17.8 billion, the same value of April 2022 (-EUR 3.7 billion, -17% compared to March 2023). A reduction of exports was observed across all agri-food products month-on-month. However, cumulative exports between January and April remained 10% higher in 2023 (+EUR 6.8 billion) compared to the same period in 2022.

This increase in exports over the beginning of the year is explained by increased exports to the **UK** (+EUR 1.7 billion, +11%, mainly cereal preparations and preparations of fruits, nuts and vegetables), as well as increased exports to **China** (+EUR 734 million, +16%, mostly cereals, cereals preparations and pigmeat) and **Türkiye** (+EUR 548, +41%, mostly cereals, cereals preparations and pigmeat).

Cumulative exports over the beginning of the year have also been higher in direction of **Ukraine** (+44%, +EUR 349 million) and the **Russian federation** (+17%, +EUR 376 million), compared to the same period in 2022. However, this is mainly explained by the fall of exports towards these countries in 2022, following the beginning of the war. Export values to Ukraine and Russia in 2023 remain comparable to their 2021 level. They are also explained by increased prices, as volumes exported to Russia have decreased for most products.

Exports towards **Egypt** decreased between January and April in comparison to the same period last year (-EUR 233 million, -26%), as well as in direction of **Iran** (-EUR 182, -50%) and **Tunisia** (-EUR 159, -36%), mostly due to a reduction in cereal exports.


EU EXPORTS VALUE REMAIN HIGH DUE TO HIGHER PRICES

The cumulative value of EU exports was higher for most products between January and April 2023 compared to the same period in 2022. However, this increase is mostly explained by **higher exports prices**, while quantities exported have decreased for many products (-3% on average across product categories).

Among the few products which saw their export volumes increase over that period, the most notable increases were for **vegetable oils** (+38%), **oilseeds and protein crops** (+17%), **margarine and other oils and fats** (+16%) and **cereals** (+7%).

On the other hand, EU exports in volumes were significantly lower between January and April 2023 compared to the same period in 2022 for **sugar and isoglucose** (-40%), **olives and olive oil** (-17%), **petfood and forage crops** (-14%), **pigmeat** (-14%) and **vegetables** (-13%).





EU AGRI-FOOD IMPORTS

EU AGRI-FOOD IMPORTS DECREASED IN APRIL 2023

EU **agri-food imports decreased** in April, at EUR 13 billion, an 11% reduction month-on-month (-EUR 1.6 billion). It was also 4% below imports of April 2022. This reduction in imports was observed across most products, at the exception of beef and veal (+12% month-on-month), margarine and other oils and fats (+15%) and pigmeat (+4%).

Over the beginning of the year, cumulative EU agrifood imports remained 7% higher than on the same period in 2022 (+EU 3.4 billion). **Brazil** was the top source of agrifood imports for the EU on that period, with EUR 5.4 billion (mostly soya and coffee), at a similar level than in 2022.

Increased imports from **Ukraine** (+EUR 1.9 billion, +66%, mostly cereals, oilseeds and sugar) explain the majority of the increased value of EU total imports from January to April, compared to last year. Imports also increased from **UK** (+EUR 397 million, +9%, mainly cereals), the **US** (+EUR 351 million, +9%, mostly oilseeds and protein crops), **Canada** (mostly wheat) and **Côte d'Ivoire** (+EUR 261 million, +23%).

On the other hand, reduced imports were observed from **Russia** (-EUR 413 million, -40%), mainly due to reductions in imports of vegetable oils and cereal preparations.

Imports also decreased from **Argentina** (-EUR 258 million, -14%, mostly in protein crops), **China** (-EUR 212 million, -7%, mainly in non-edibles), the **Philippines** (-EUR 209 million, -39%; mainly in margarine and other oils and fats) and **Moldova** (-EUR 192 million, -43%).

HIGH IMPORTS OF SUGAR IN THE BEGINNING OF 2023

Increased imports of **cereals**, both in value (+EUR 1.8 billion, +60%) and in volume (+59%), explain a large share of the increase of EU imports over the beginning of the year compared to 2022.

A large increase of imports of **tobacco products** can be observed (+EUR 546 million, +57%). However, this is partly explained by increased imports prices (+36% in unit value year-on-year).

Imports of **sugar and isoglucose** more than doubled in value year-on-year between January and April (+EUR 421 million, +140%) and increased significantly in volume as well (+83%). Combined with the reduction in exports, this resulted in a degradation of the **trade balance** for sugar and isoglucose from -EUR 95 million in 2022 to -EUR 529 million in 2023 (January to April).


