The number is significantly higher because since 2021/2022, 0.25 L white milk is only available as organic. Please note however, that the supplier for the milk regime would have been able to deliver $100 \%$ organic white plain drinking milk, however the schools decide for themselves if they decide to order organic or conventional milk. $61.8 \%$ of the yogurt distributed in 2021/2022 originates from organic production. $35.48 \%$ of the school fruits \& vegetables come from organic production. |
