| Comments | Expenditure is broken down by product groups proportionally according to the number of portions of each product group that were supplied/distributed to children. It includes expenditures for products that could not be supplied/distributed to schools but were instead donated to charities (= cases of force majeure linked to the Covid-19 pandemic): for school fruit and vegetables, approximately EUR 1854 264, of which EUR 1448463 EUR from the EU and EUR 405801 from national funds (including VAT), for school milk, approximately EUR 302 213, of which EUR 200978 from the EU and EUR 101235 from national funds (including VAT). <br> The Covid-19 pandemic affected implementation of the scheme in school year 2020/2021 in terms of number of participating children, number of distributed portions etc. Nevertheless, changes and flexibilities implemented at national level influenced positively budget execution and helped reach a relatively high level of spending in terms of EU aid (expenditure was covered from EU budget, except VAT, first). |  |  |  |  |  |  |  |

This prevented the full use of the budget for the accompanying educational measures in school year 2020/2021. | Comments | A single aid rate per portion ( 0,17 EUR/0,73 PLN for respectively school fruit <br> and vegetables and school milk) is set in the national regulation for the school <br> scheme. It is split into EU and national aid proportionally to the global <br> amounts of expenditure on deliveries. In school year 2020/2021, two <br> approaches to payment system were applied. Initially, a single aid per portion <br> was financed from EU and national aid proportionally to the overall national <br> and EU budget set in the national regulation. Afterwards, expenditure on <br> products deliveries were covered fully at the first place from EU budget <br> (except VAT). Additionally to those amounts VAT was added financed from <br> national budget (5\% or 8\% for fruit and vegetable products). |  |
