- Announcement by Commissioner Hogan in September last year
- Operational since January this year
- Chaired by former Dutch Agriculture Minister
 Cees Veerman
- 12 senior experts
- Final report to be adopted in autumn





Mandate

- Look into the functioning of the food supply chain
- Provide advice on how to improve the position of farmers in the supply chain
- Make recommendations and proposing policy initiatives
- Including possible legislation under the CAP competence





Areas of interests

- Market transparency
- Access to financing and futures markets
- Contractualisation and contractual relations
- Collective self-help tools (including collective bargaining and competition issues)





Working method

- Hearing of external experts
- Discussions among members on basis of issue papers
- Outreach and input from representatives from the EP and Council
