Member States' support decisions applicable for claim year 2021

The synthesis presented in this document reflects the content of Member States' notifications available to the Commission services as they stood on 30 June 2021.

It is made available without prejudice to any finding in respect of their compliance with the regulatory framework.

1. VOLUNTARY COUPLED SUPPORT IN A NUTSHELL

Member States may use up to a maximum percentage of their annual national ceiling for direct payments to finance **voluntary coupled support** (VCS) (Chapter 1 of Title IV of Regulation (EU) No 1307/2013 of the European Parliament and the Council ('the basic act' hereafter)).

According to the currently applicable rules¹, the Member States may only decide to grant VCS to a list of sectors and productions² **in sectors or regions, where specific types of farming or specific agricultural sectors particularly important for economic, social or environmental reasons undergo certain difficulties**. Coupled support is a production-limiting scheme that shall take the form of an annual payment based on fixed areas and yields or on a fixed number of animals and shall respect financial ceilings to be determined by Member States for each measure and notified to the Commission (Article 52(6) of the basic act).

Each Member State may only use a limited part of its national ceiling for direct payments to grant VCS. This **budgetary limit** is 8+2%, which, under certain conditions, may be increased to 13+2%. Further increase is possible only if certain specific needs require so, in which case the decision of the Member State is also subject to approval by the European Commission.

The Member States could apply VCS as from claim year 2015. They may review their support decisions on an annual basis. The notifications are normally due by 1 August of the previous year.³ However, exceptionally due to the relatively late adoption of the EU rules for the transitional period (2021-2022) before the post-2022 reform ([REGULATION \(EU\) 2020/2220](#)), the notification of VCS support decisions for claim year 2022 was only due by 19 February 2021.

2. VCS DECISIONS FOR CLAIM YEAR 2021 - OVERVIEW

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 27 Member States (i.e. all Member States⁴ except for DE) decided to apply VCS from claim year 2015. Due to Brexit (the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union) this number decreased to 26 (i.e. still all Member States except for DE) as from claim year 2020. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Number of support measures: The number of measures has fluctuated between 250 and 260 since 2015, with **260 measures** in claim year 2021.
- Budget: The annual monetary allocation has been around **EUR 4.18 billion per year**. This represents 11.1% of the direct payments budget and a 0.1% decrease in comparison to CY 2020.
- Support distribution per sector: The **three animal-based sectors** have always been, and also remained after this review, the largest VCS beneficiaries, receiving **73% of all coupled support**. The most important area-based beneficiaries are **protein crops** (11.3%), **sugar beet and fruits and vegetables** (respectively with 4.4% and 4.3% share).

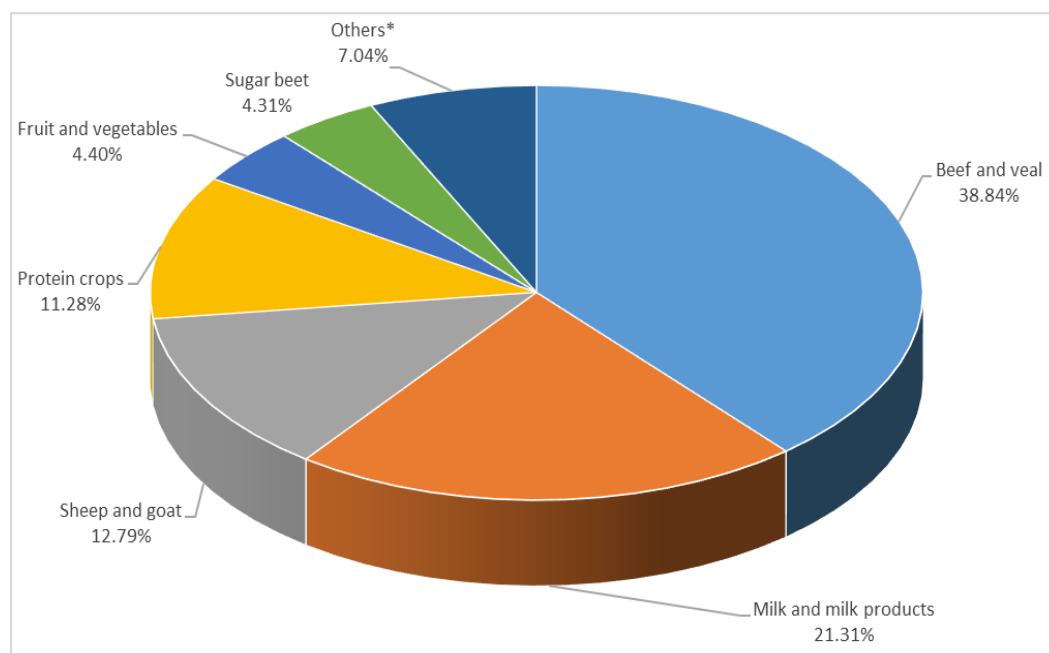

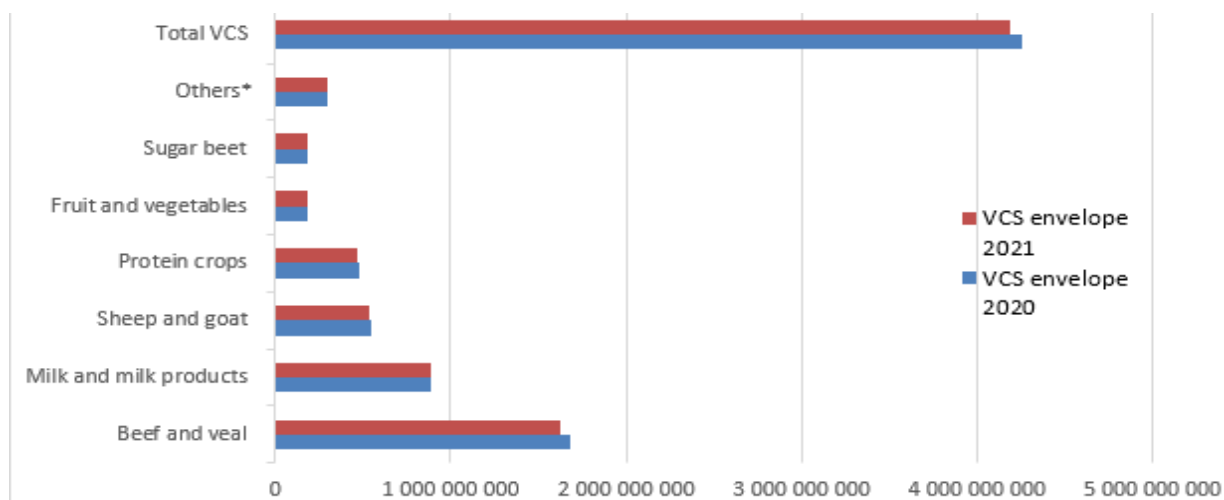

Member States' overview:

- **18 Member States** (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Latvia, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Spain, Slovakia and Slovenia) decided to modify their previous support decisions.
- **8 Member States** (Austria, The Czech Republic, Denmark, Ireland, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, and Sweden) left their previous support decisions unchanged. NB: Germany maintained its former decision not to grant VCS.

3. OVERVIEW FOR THE MAIN SECTORS⁵

3.1 Beef and veal sector

VCS decisions in general:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 24 Member States decided to grant coupled support for beef and veal as from claim year 2015. This number decreased to 23 Member States from claim year 2017. Due to Brexit, it decreased further to **22 Member States** from claim year 2020. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Number of support measures (EU27): In comparison to the former support decisions, it decreased from 54 to **52 measures**, as from claim year 2020. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Budget: The sector's monetary allocation (EU27) increased by some 0.8% from EUR 1 683 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 1 626 million** in claim year 2021.

The beef and veal sector has always been, and remains for claim year 2021, the biggest VCS beneficiary; its share in the total VCS budget **almost 39%**. This represents **4.33%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It remained roughly stable at around 19.3 million heads⁶ for years. As from claim year 2020, it decreased to **18.9 million heads**. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, the average support rate slightly decreased (by 2 EUR/head), thus reaching **86 EUR/head** (EU27 average since claim year 2020) in comparison to its previous level. This still exceeds the average support level available under the other animal based sectors (milk and milk products; sheep and goat meat).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged since 2020.
- **Modified** measures: In 2021, 14 Member States (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Finland, France, Italy, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain) carried out modifications, which affected the eligibility conditions (HR, RO, LT, PT), the model for modulating the amount of aid/unit (FR) and the financial envelopes (BE-Flanders/Wallonia, BG, EL, ES, FI, FR, IT, LT, HU, PL, SI, SK).

3.2 Milk and milk products sector

VCS decisions in general⁷:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 19 Member States decided to grant coupled support for the milk and milk products sector as from claim year 2015. This decreased to 18 from claim year 2017, grew back to **19 Member States** from claim year 2019 and remained at that level in claim year 2021.

- Number of support measures (EU27): in comparison to the former support decision, it increased from 31 to **32 measures**, as from claim year 2020. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Budget: The sector's monetary allocation (EU27) increased by 0.34% from EUR 889 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 892 million** in claim year 2021.

The milk and milk products sector has always been, and also remained after the review for claim year 2021, the 2nd biggest VCS beneficiary (after the beef and veal sector). Its share from VCS increased a little **above 21%** (EU27). This represents around **2.4%** of the annual national ceiling for direct payments.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It increased from 11.3 million heads in 2020 to **11.5 million heads** in 2021.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, the average support rate decreased back to **78 EUR/head** (2019 level) from 79 EUR/head (EU27 average since claim year 2020).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged since 2020.
- **Modified** measures: In 2021, 15 Member States (Belgium – Wallonia, Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, France, Hungary, Poland, Portugal, Italy, Lithuania, Latvia, Romania, Spain, Slovenia and Slovakia) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (EE, HR, LT, RO), the model for modulating the amount of aid/unit (BG, HR), the difficulties, the importance, the fixed number of animals (EE) and the financial envelopes (BE-Wallonia, BG, EE, ES, FR, HU, IT, LV, LT, PL, PT, SI, SK), the estimated unit rate (EE).

3.3 Sheep and goat meat sector

VCS decisions in general⁸:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 22 Member States decided to grant coupled support for the sheep and goat meat sector as from claim year 2015. This decreased to 21 Member States from claim year 2017, and dropped further to 20 Member States as from claim year 2020. In 2021, it increased back to **21 Member States**.
- Number of support measures (EU27): in comparison to the former support decisions, it decreased from 36 to 35 measures in claim year 2020. In 2021, it increased back to **36 measures**.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked decreased roughly by 1% from EUR 542 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 535.7 million** in claim year 2021.

Though the sheep and goat meat sector has always been, and also remains for claim year 2021, the 3rd biggest VCS beneficiary (after the beef and veal and the milk and milk products sectors), its share in VCS remained **slightly below 13%**. This represents around **1.4%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It remained stable at around 41.3 million heads for years and decreased to **41.2 million heads** as from claim year 2020. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, the average unit amount of support (EU27 average since claim year 2020) remained unchanged at **13 EUR/head** (since 2019).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: Cyprus abolished 1 measure (by merging it into another one) and Slovenia introduced a new one.
- **Modified** measures: In 2014, 14 Member States (Belgium – Wallonia, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Greece, France, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Latvia, Poland, Portugal, Romania and Slovakia) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR, LV, LT, RO), the model for modulating the amount of aid/unit (FR), the fixed number of animals (CY, LV), justification (LV) and the financial envelopes (BE-Wallonia, BG, CY, EL, ES, FR, HU, IT, LV, LT, PL, PT, SK).

3.4 Protein crops sector

To recall, the Member States may increase their annual national ceiling for VCS by up to 2% if they decide to use at least 2% of their annual national ceiling set out in Annex II of the basic act to support the production of protein crops (Article 53(3) of the basic act).

VCS decisions in general⁹:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 16 Member States decided to grant such coupled support from claim year 2015. This decreased to 15 from claim year 2017, and increased back to **16 Member States** from claim year 2019. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Number of support measures (EU27): in comparison to the former support decisions, it remained unchanged with **28 measures** as from claim year 2019. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked decreased slightly by 0.55% from EUR 474.9 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 472.4 million** in claim year 2021.

The protein crops sector has always been, and remains for claim year 2021 the 4th biggest VCS beneficiary (after the animal-based sectors) and the biggest area-based VCS beneficiary. Its share from VCS remained **slightly above 11%**, which represents some **1.3%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU28): It remained unchanged with **4.1 million ha**.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, it further decreased to **114 EUR/ha** from the previous 116.5 EUR/ha in 2019 and 115 EUR/ha (EU27 average since claim year 2020).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged.
- **Modified** measures: In 2021, 13 Member States (Bulgaria, Croatia, Finland, France, Hungary, Greece, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Spain and Slovakia) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the financial envelope (BG, EL, ES, FI, FR, HU, IT, LV, LT, PL, SK), the deletion of the modulated unit rate (PL) and the eligibility conditions (EL, HR, LT, RO).

3.5 Fruit and vegetables sector

VCS decisions in general¹⁰:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', **19 Member States** decided to grant such coupled support from claim year 2015. This remained **unchanged** under the following reviews including the reviews for claim year 2020 and the notification for claim year 2021.
- Number of support measures (EU27): in comparison with the former support decisions, it remained unchanged with **54 measures** as from claim year 2019. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked increased by 0.27% from EUR 183.6 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 184.2 million** in claim year 2021.

The fruit and vegetables sector has always been, and also remains for claim year 2021, the 5th biggest VCS beneficiary and also the 2nd most important area-based beneficiary (after the protein crops sector). Its share from VCS slightly increased to **4.3%**, which represents some **0.5%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU27): Increased from 720 345 ha to **720 994 ha**.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, it decreased from the previous 262 EUR/ha (EU27 average since claim year 2020) to **255 EUR/ha**.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: No new measures were created, nor any existing one deleted.
- **Modified** measures: In 2021, 17 Member States (Bulgaria, Croatia, Finland, France, Hungary, Greece, Estonia, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Spain, and Slovakia) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (EL, HR, LT, PL, RO, SI), the fixed areas (HR, SI), the model for modulating the amount of aid/unit (BG), justification (FI) and the financial envelopes (BG, EL, EE, ES, FR, HU, IT, LV, LT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK).

3.6 Sugar beet sector

VCS decisions in general¹¹:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 10 Member States decided to grant such coupled support from claim year 2015. This increased to **11 Member States** from claim year 2017, and remained **unchanged** from claim year 2019, including 2020 and 2021.
- Number of support measures (EU27): in comparison with the former support decision, it remained unchanged with **12 measures** as from claim year 2019. In 2021, there was no change in this regard.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked decreased by 0.88% from EUR 182.2 million in claim year 2020 to **EUR 180.6 million** in claim year 2021.

The sugar beet sector has always been, and also remains for claim year 2021, the 6th biggest VCS beneficiary and also the 3rd most important area-based beneficiary. Its share from VCS increased from 4% back to **4.3%**, which represents some **0.5%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU28): In 2021, it remained at **507 669 ha** (claim year 2020 level).
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2021, it decreased from the previous 359 EUR/ha (EU27 average since claim year 2020) to **356 EUR/ha**.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: No new measures were created, nor any existing ones deleted.
- **Modified** measures: In 2021, 9 Member States (Croatia, Greece, Finland, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Spain and Slovakia) carried out modifications of already existing measures. The changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR, RO) and the financial envelopes (ES, FI, HU, IT, LT, PL, SK).

4 OVERVIEW FOR THE REMAINING SECTORS¹²

Whereas the 6 biggest VCS sectors represent some 93% of all VCS allocations (EU27 average), the remaining 15 sectors represent only some 7%, i.e. 0.8% of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

In the framework of their 'original support decisions' as from claim year 2015, **13 Member States** decided to grant VCS for the benefit of one or more of the following sectors: cereals, oilseeds, grain legumes, flax, hemp, rice, nuts, starch potato, seeds, olive oil, silkworms and hops. No Member State decided to support the following sectors: short rotation coppice, dried fodder and cane & chicory.

This does **not change** for claim year 2021.

The changes concerned the financial envelopes (IT – sugar beet, cereals, olive oil, rice; LV – cereal, starch potato, dried fodder, seed potato, cereal seed, oilseeds; LT – cereals, seed potato; PT- rice) and the eligibility conditions (LV- cereals, RO – potato seeds, grain legumes, hemp, rice, silkworms).

In 2021, the share of annual direct payments amounts dedicated to these sectors remained unchanged, at 0.8% (claim year 2020 level).
