








Trade is essential for global food security






OECD-FAO Agricultural Outlook 2020-2029

Export share of world's five largest exporters in 2029





Agricultural Commodity Prices



Thanks to transparency?




- Transparency underpins trust

Change in calorie availability in COVID scenario compared to Outlook baseline








Agricultural production reduced as a result of Covid19: high value products to be more affected

Change in production in COVID scenario compared to Outlook baseline




