




# MONITORING EU AGRI-FOOD TRADE: DEVELOPMENTS JANUARY- MARCH 2020



#### JANUARY - MARCH 2020: EU27 MONTHLY AGRI-FOOD TRADE PICKING UP

During the first three months of 2020, the EU27 agri-food trade (exports plus imports) reached a value of EUR 78.6 billion; i.e. 4.7% more than in January-March 2019, despite the COVID-19 pandemic developing. The current growth was driven by a boost in agri-food exports which increased by 6.2% compared to the corresponding period in 2019, reaching **EUR 46.8 billion**. Similarly, EU27 imports picked up and reached **EUR 31.8 billion**, 2.6% higher than the same three months period in 2019 and 12.5% above the level in February 2020.

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EU27 does not include the United Kingdom which left the EU on 31/01/2020. Trade with the UK is reported as trade with a third country in this publication, for the current period and the reference periods, although single market conditions still applied to the UK. UK trade data may be underestimated at the time of reporting and official statistics may be corrected at later stage.



### **EU27** EXPORTS TO CHINA STILL AT HIGH LEVEL, WHILE EXPORTS TO **UK** CONTINUE TO FALL

On a year over year basis, the highest increases in export values (January-March 2020 compared to January-March 2019, EUR million) continued to be recorded in trade with China (+1136, +41%). This upward trend was largely driven by lasting consequences of African Swine Fever in China as well as, to some extent, by the impact of COVID-19 outbreak. High increases in export values to China were hence recorded for pig meat (+240% January-March 2019), offal compared (+47%), infant food (+25%) and wheat. Other top destinations, for which the value of EU27 agri-food exports increased most, include Saudi Arabia (+312, +38%), **Morocco** (+240, +47%) - in both cases this was driven by high exports of barley and wheat; the Russian Federation (+189, +10%) and the United States (+187, +4%). While the biggest gains in EU agri-food exports to the US in January-March 2020 were reported for waters and soft drinks (+33%), preparations of vegetables and fruits (+23%), and pasta and pastry (+14%), exports of olive oil (+64%), cheese, wine and spirits started to increase in March 2020 when comparing to February 2020.

During the first quarter of 2020, EU exports also continued to increase significantly to Japan (+183, +12%) and Algeria (+178, +31%).



On the other hand, EU27 export values in the first three months of 2020 continued to fall most to the **United Kingdom** (-827, -8%), although single market conditions still apply to trade with the UK. EU agri-food exports to the UK that declined most in value terms remained the same as in previous months, namely wine (-22%), cigars and cigarettes (-49%), and preparations of fruits and vegetables (-13%).

EU27 exports continued to decline as well as to **Hong Kong** (-158, -23%) and **Lebanon** (-93, 35%). Other destinations with notable reductions were Singapore (-71, -16%) and Indonesia (-52, -21%).

The main export destinations in the first three months of 2020 were the UK, the USA, China, Switzerland and Russia. More than 50% of EU27 agri-food exports went to these five countries.


## **EU27** EXPORTS OF COMMODITIES AND PRIMARY PRODUCTS ON CONTINUED GROWTH; EXPORTS OF NON-EDIBLE AND PROCESSED PRODUCTS DECLINE

Looking at product categories, the increase in export values (January-March 2020 compared to January-March 2019) was driven in particular by continued strong export growth of **wheat** (+979, +71%), **pig meat** (+901, +58%), **coarse grains** (+354, +57%), infant food (+177, +9%) and offal meat (+139, +19%). On the other hand, major losses for EU exports (in value terms) remained to be reported for **wine** (-233, -7%), **raw hides and skins** (-172, -67%), **spirits and liqueurs** (-144, -8%), beet and cane sugar (-97, -45%) and cotton (-64, -16%).

The top EU agri-food export products in the period examined included wine, pig meat, wheat, infant food, pasta and pastry. They accounted for over 25% of EU27 total exports.

### INCREASING IMPORTS OF OILSEEDS AND VEGETABLE OILS FROM CANADA

In regard to EU27 agri-food imports, their value during January-March 2020 compared to January-March 2019 increased most from **Canada** (+366, +101%). This growth was driven by very high imports of rapeseed, soya beans and rapeseed oil. Indonesia (+335, +35%) came second with a 60% increase of palm oil imports. Other major increases included **Cote d'Ivoire**, driven by higher import values of cocoa beans (+238, +30%), **Turkey** (+177, 170% - fruits and citrus, preparations of vegetables) and Malaysia (+115, +27% - palm oil).



The value of monthly imports continued to fall most from the **United Kingdom** (-460, -11%), in particular for spirits and liqueurs (-21%), chocolate and confectionary (-20%) and coarse grains (-46%). Other countries for which EU27 imports

fell most include **Ukraine** (-230, -12%, decline driven by smaller imports of corn and wheat), **USA** (-123, -4% -in particular lower imports of soya beans by 30%) and oilcakes (-74%)); Australia (-95, -19% - oilseeds, wool) and India (-58, -8% other feed and feed ingredients, oilcakes).

The top EU agri-food origins in the three months period include the UK, USA, Brazil, Ukraine and China. They have accounted for over 38% of EU27 imports.

# **EU27** IMPORTS INCREASE DRIVEN BY HIGHER IMPORTS OF FRUITS, PALM OIL, OILSEEDS AND VEGETABLE OILS

Looking at product categories, the highest increases in import values were reported for **fresh** and dried tropical fruit (+547, 17%), palm and palm kernel oil (+317, +26%), oilseeds other than soya beans (+288, 30%; primarily driven by higher imports of rapeseed and sunflower seeds), fresh and dried fruits (+200, +13%), and other vegetable oils (+189, +26%; rapeseed and sunflower seed oils).

On the other hand, imports of **coarse grains** (-451, -33%), **oilcakes** (-319, -18%), **raw tobacco** (-180, -25%), wheat (-109, -33%) and spirits and liqueurs (-106, -13%) decreased most in value terms. Furthermore, import values of wool and other feed and feed ingredients continued to fall each by around EUR 60 billion.

The top EU agri-food import products in the first three months of 2020 included tropical fruits, other fruits excluding tropical and citrus, unroasted coffee and tea, palm and palm kernel oil and oilcakes. They have accounted for nearly 50% of EU27 imports.

As a result, the agri-food export surplus during the period January-March 2020 stood at EUR **14.9 billion**, an increase by 15% compared to the corresponding period in 2019. This net trade balance remained boosted by continued strong exports of **pig meat**, **wheat** and **coarse grains**. By contrast, the EU27 net trade balance further deteriorated to reach negative values for **beet and cane sugar**, **raw hides and skins**, and **ethanol**.
