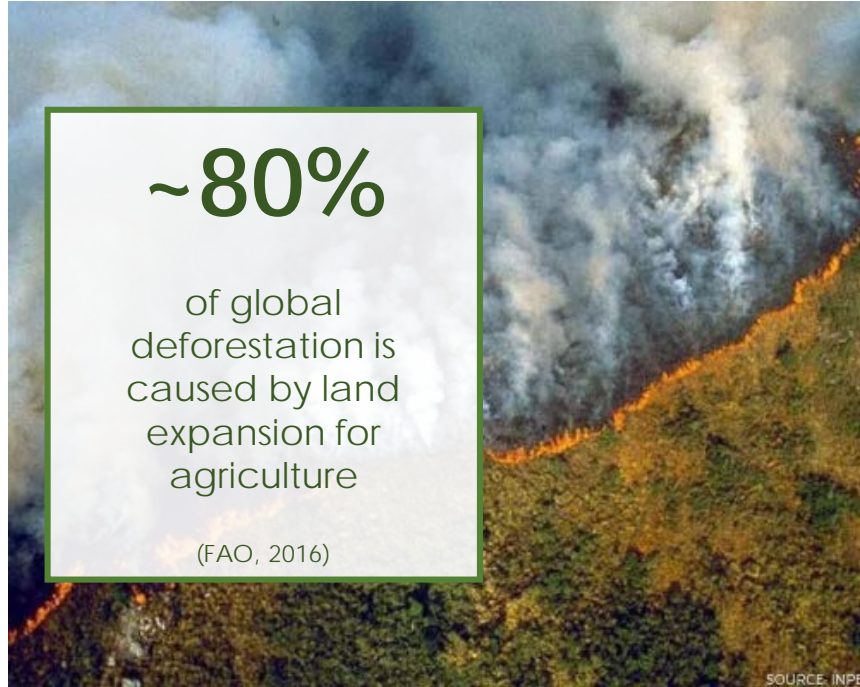

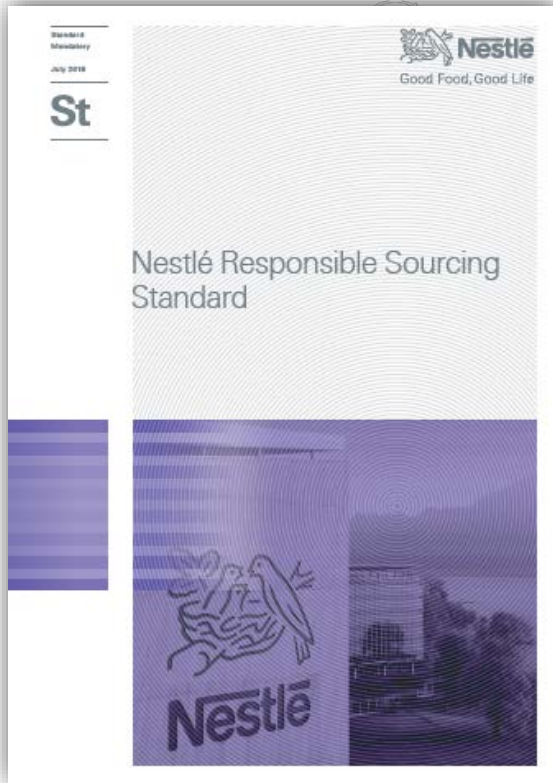

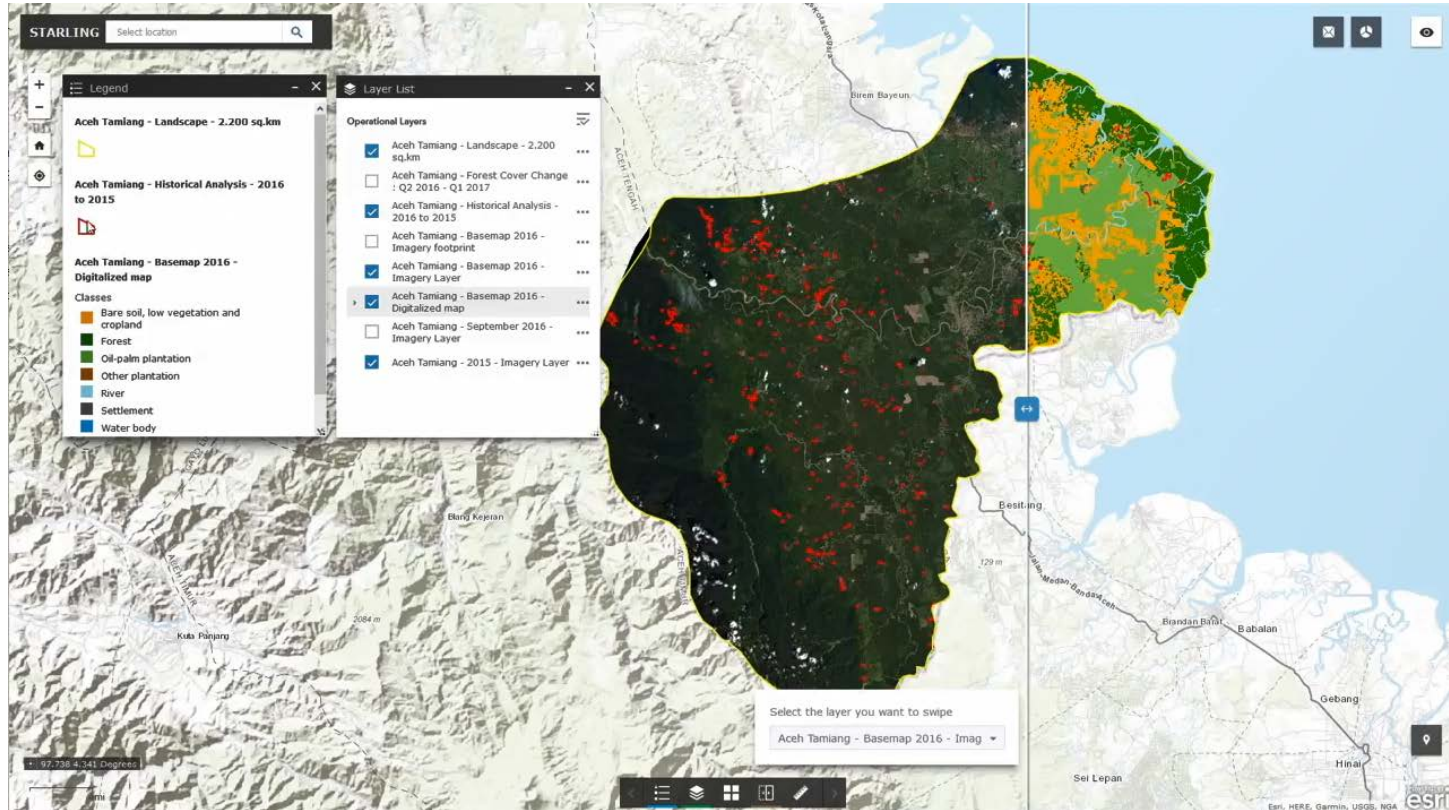

- EU to incentivize **end-to-end transparency** in global agri-supply chains to ensure accountability of each player
- EU-wide regulation on **mandatory human rights and environmental due diligence** as part of a holistic policy toolbox
