




MONITORING EU AGRI-FOOD TRADE: DEVELOPMENTS JANUARY-OCTOBER 2021



OCTOBER 2021: EU27 AGRI-FOOD TRADE VALUE STABILISED AT HIGH LEVELS

During the first ten months of 2021, EU27 agri-food trade (exports + imports) reached a value of **€268.1 billion**; i.e. 6% more than in January-October 2020. EU27 exports increased by 7% compared to the corresponding period in 2020, reaching **€162.8 billion**. EU27 imports attained **€105.3 billion**, 4% more than the corresponding value for the first ten months in 2020. Looking at monthly developments, both EU agri-food export and import values in October 2021 were slightly lower (>0.7%) than in the previous month.

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EU27 Agri-food trade stabilised at high levels

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EU27 does not include the **United Kingdom** which left the EU on 31/01/2020. Trade with the UK is reported as trade with a third country.

EU27 EXPORTS: INCREASING EXPORTS TO THE US, EXPORTS IN VALUE TO UK OVER 2020 LEVELS

On a year over year basis, for the period January-October 2021, EU27 export values increased most to the **United States** ($2 \le 454 \text{ m}$, 27%), when compared with the same period in 2020. While the majority of EU agri-food products to the US observed higher export values, the biggest increases were noted for wine ($2 \le 995 \text{ m}$, 232%), spirits and liqueurs ($2 \le 453 \text{ m}$, 220%), chocolate and confectionery ($2 \le 201 \text{ m}$, 226%).

South Korea ($\nearrow \in 698$ m, $\cancel{28\%}$) came second with EU agri-food exports boosted by higher sales of wine, pig meat and wheat. **Switzerland** followed ($\nearrow \in 588$ m, $\cancel{28\%}$) with an important increase for a wide range of agri-food products.

Other noteworthy changes, for which the value of EU27 agri-food exports have increased most since January 2021, include Norway ($2 \notin 473 \text{ m}$, 212% most of agri-food, with cigars and cigarettes leading) and Israel ($2 \notin 395 \text{ m}$, 23% live animals, beverages and spirits, cereals).

Over the same period, the value of exports to the **United Kingdom** were marginally higher than during the same period in 2020 (\nearrow 39 m, \neg 0.1%). Exports were particularly depressed in the beginning of the year, after which they rebounded. Against the backdrop of lower EU export values observed for the majority of agri-food products, exports of cigars and cigarettes (\searrow €318 m, >51%), pig meat (\searrow €149 m, \searrow 18%), tropical fruit (\searrow €146 m, **∖**33%), and fruit juices (\searrow €140 m, \checkmark 22%) decreased most. However, EU exports of some products such as wine (/€555 m, /26%), live animals (/€236 m, /93%), bulbs and roots (/€196 m, /27%), cut flowers (/€189 m, /38%) as welle as spirits and liqueurs (/€149 m, /32%) have continued to increase most in value terms, compared to the same period in 2020.

On the other hand, for the first ten months of 2021, EU27 export values continued to fall most to **Saudi Arabia** (\S €548 m, \S 15%), particular driven by lower exports of wheat, barley and cereal preparations. Other destinations, for which the value of EU27 agri-food exports has decreased most since January 2021 compared to the same period last year, include **Hong Kong** (\S €245 m, \S 12% - infant food and other cereal preparations, pig meat) and **Kuwait** (\S €130 m, \S 21%- wide range of agri-food products with biggest declines of milk and cream, cigars and cigarettes).



The main EU27 export destinations in the first ten months of 2021 were the United Kingdom, the United States, China, Switzerland and Japan. 51% of EU agri-food exports went to these five countries.

EU27 EXPORTS: STRONG PERFORMANCE OF EU EXPORTS OF WINE, SPIRITS AND LIQUEURS

Looking at product categories, the rise in EU export values remained to be driven, in particular, by trade in **wine** ($2 \in 2 997 \text{ m}$, 227%), and **spirits and liqueurs** ($2 \in 1 463 \text{ m}$, 226%). Other noteworthy increases in value terms were observed for **rapeseed and sunflower oils** ($2 \in 808 \text{ m}$, 231%), chocolate and confectionery ($2 \in 744 \text{ m}$, 211%), coarse grains ($2 \in 686 \text{ m}$, 231%).

On the other hand, EU exports of **infant food** (\lor €763 m, \lor 10%), **pig meat** (\lor €348 m, \lor 4%) and **wheat** (\lor €304 m, \lor 5%) saw the biggest declines in value terms compared to the same period in 2020. Significant decreases were also observed for cigars and cigarettes (\lor €162 m, \lor 4%), vegetables (\lor €152 m, \lor 3%) and tropical fruit (\lor €150 m, \lor 11%).


The EU agri-food product categories with highest export values in the period January-October 2021 included wine, pig meat, pasta and pastry, chocolate and confectionery, spirits and liqueurs. These products accounted for more than 27% of EU27 total agri-food exports.

EU27 IMPORTS: STRONG DECLINE IN EU IMPORTS FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM

During the period January-October 2021, the total value of EU27 agri-food imports increased by 3.9% compared to the first ten months of 2020. While in January and February imports were lower than in years before, they bounced back to higher than usual levels in summer. The value of EU imports fell most from the **United Kinadom** (\second €3 287 m, >26%). While lower import values from UK were reported for almost all agri-food product categories except for notably spirits and liqueurs (*P*€26 m, 2 %), those with the most significant import reductions in value include tropical fruits, nuts and spices (\v€243 m, \v88%), wine (\v€188 m, \v66%), pet food (\searrow €173 m, \angle 28%), vegetables (\searrow €155 m, \v49%), and cheese (\v€143 m, \v32%). Monthly EU import values from the UK in October 2021 were 20% lower compared to the same month in 2020, after having fallen sharply since January 2021 (\searrow 24% in September, \searrow 18% in August).

A further decrease was also observed in EU imports from the **United States** ($\searrow \in 625 \text{ m}, \searrow 8\%$) compared to the first ten months of 2020. This was primarily driven by reduced imports of tropical fruit, nuts and spices ($\searrow \in 348 \text{ m}, \searrow 16\%$), wheat ($\searrow \in 156 \text{ m}, \searrow 64\%$), and raw tobacco ($\searrow \in 109 \text{ m},$ $\searrow 45\%$). On the other hand, a notable increase in value of EU imports was reported for US oil cakes ($\nearrow \in 74 \text{ m}, \ 793\%$), mainly quantity-driven but- also to some extent, price-driven.

Other destinations, for which the value of EU27 agri-food imports fell most since January 2021 compared to the first ten months of 2020, include **Canada** ($\searrow \in 256$ m, $\searrow 11\%$ - rapeseed seeds), Switzerland ($\searrow \in 119$ m, $\searrow 3\%$ - different agri-food products), and Tunisia ($\searrow \in 117$ m, $\searrow 19\%$ - olive oil).



On the other hand, countries for which the EU27 import values have kept increasing most since January 2021 include **Brazil** ($2 \in 1.607 \text{ m}$, 216% - 30% soya beans – mainly price-driven), **Indonesia** ($2 \in 750 \text{ m}$, 220% - fatty acids), **Argentina** ($2 \in 597 \text{ m}$, 216% - soya bean oilcakes- increase mainly price driven), Ukraine ($2 \in 581 \text{ m}$, 212%), Australia ($2 \in 546 \text{ m}$, 252%), and China ($2 \in 503 \text{ m}$, 212%).

The top origins for EU agri-food imports in the first ten months of 2021 included Brazil, United Kingdom, United States, Ukraine and China. These countries accounted for 36% of EU27 agri-food imports in value terms.

EU27 IMPORTS: STRONG INCREASE IN EU VALUE OF IMPORTS OF OILCAKES AND SOYA BEANS DRIVEN BY HIGHER PRICES

Looking at product categories over the first ten months of 2021, the highest decreases in import values continued to be reported for **tropical fruit**, **nuts and spices** ($\Im \in 602 \text{ m}$, $\Im 5\%$), **fruit juices** ($\Im \in 200 \text{ m}$, $\Im 12\%$), **raw tobacco** ($\Im \in 155 \text{ m}$, $\Im 10\%$), meat preparations ($\Im \in 144 \text{ m}$, $\Im 15\%$), and wine ($\Im \in 141 \text{ m}$, $\Im 9\%$).

On the other hand, EU agri-food import values increased most for **oilcakes** (\nearrow 1 269 m, $\cancel{2}25\%$, price-driven), **soya beans** ($\cancel{2} \in 1 263$ m, $\cancel{2}30\%$, price-driven), **fatty acids and waxes** ($\cancel{2} \in 915$ m, $\cancel{2}36\%$), palm and palm kernel oil ($\cancel{2} \in 858$ m, $\cancel{1}9\%$, price-driven), and rapeseed and sunflower oils ($\cancel{2} \in 517$ m, $\cancel{1}9\%$).

The EU agri-food products with highest import values in the period January-October 2021 included fruits (tropical and other than citrus), oilcakes, soya beans, palm & palm kernel oil, unroasted coffee and tea in bulk. These products accounted for nearly 37% of EU27 agri-food imports' value.

EXPANDING SURPLUS IN EU27 AGRI-FOOD TRADE

During the period January-October 2021, the EU27 agri-food trade surplus' value stood at **C57.5 billion**, an increase of 14% compared to the corresponding period in 2020. This net trade balance remained to be driven by high exports of wine, spirits and liqueurs, chocolate and confectionery, and cheese.
