I wish to invite you to the next meeting of the Civil Dialogue Group (1) that will take place **in hybrid format**:

in Brussels, Centre de Conférence Albert Borschette, Meeting Room: 3.A and online, via the Interactio platform on 13 November 2023 from 10:00 to 17:30.

Meeting documentation will be available via CircaBC.

Interpretation is foreseen from EN - FR - DE - ES - IT - PLto EN - FR - DE - ES - IT - PL

The interpretation will be cancelled if no participant for a given language have registered in time for the meeting.

Participation:

The number of participants allowed to attend the meeting is limited **per organisation** as follows:

- Active participants (possibility to take the floor):
 - O At the venue (physical attendance): up to 2 experts

 The number of experts entitled to reimbursement is limited to 1 expert per organisation.
 - On-line (in addition to above): up to 4 experts

IMPORTANT: **registration in AGM**, and thus the identification of active participants, is **compulsory**.

• Additional observers (participating online in listening mode only)

After the registration deadline, the AGM correspondents will receive an **observer link** to allow additional participation in listening mode only.

While the use of the observer link is not limited, it is strictly reserved for CDG member organisations. Disseminating the link outside the member organisation may result in exclusion from the group.

No AGM registration is required for this type of attendance.

Registration:

For all **active** participants – participating online or physically - <u>AGM registration is</u> <u>compulsory</u>.

- The AGM correspondents of each CDG member organisation are kindly requested to designate and register the active participants via AGM as soon as possible.
- In case of an **umbrella** organisation, the registration should mention the name of that umbrella organisation (which was granted the CDG membership) and not the specific name of each participant' organisation.
- Only the participants registered via AGM can be authorised to join the meeting actively.
- The **listed active participants** should confirm via AGM their attendance **no later than 8 November 2023** and **indicate via AGM** how they intend to participate: **physically or online**.
- After the above deadline, the online participants will receive an email with all technical details for the connection by videoconference and the physical participants will receive their authorisation document to enter the building ("V-pass").
- Attention: Commission will strictly apply the abovementioned deadline for registration: no additional physical participant can be accepted after the given deadline, since it affects the choice of venue/meeting room and other preparations for the meeting.

Participation/Reimbursement:

- One physical participant appointed by their organisation will be entitled to reimbursement of travel costs, an accommodation allowance, and a daily allowance (see reimbursement details in Annex).
- For delegates participating online there will be no reimbursement of travel or any other costs.
- Physical participants will be asked to pass through an obligatory control (X-ray devices and/or walk-through detectors) when entering the building.
