

CANADA

- » Canada launched anti-dumping investigation into imports of wheat gluten from Austria, Belgium, France, Germany, Lithuania and Australia in August 2020
- » Despite efforts from European Commission, Starch Europe and impacted companies demonstrating prices to Canada equivalent or higher than to rest of world, preliminary duties imposed in December 2020 ranging from 10% to 26.2 %
- » Confirmed in April 2021 and finally published on website in August; Starch Europe statement expressing disappointment also published
- » Ongoing discussions on next steps
