ATMs for Ukraine: Provisional and Definitive Safeguard Measures

	Provisional Measures	Definitive Measures
Scope	Products covered by ATMs	Products covered by ATMs
Criteria	Adverse effect on market of EU or one or several MS accompanied by “critical circumstances where delay would cause damage that would be difficult to repair”	Adverse effect on market of EU or one or several MS
Trigger of assessment	Duly substantiated request by a MS	Duly substantiated request by a MS or ex officio by Commission
Timeline of assessment	21 days	4 months
Comitology	Advisory procedure	Examination procedure
Measures	Any measure which is necessary – in case DCFTA quotas are reimposed they are exhausted by quantities already imported that year	Any measure which is necessary – in case DCFTA quotas are reimposed they are exhausted by quantities already imported that year

Automatic Safeguard - Principles

- “Emergency brake” for eggs, poultry, sugar, oats, groats, honey and maize
- Objective: Stabilise imports at levels of 1 July 2021- 31 December 2023
- Measures to be taken within 14 days:
 - Reintroduction of DCFTA quotas minus imports the same calendar year
 - For 1 Jan-5 Jun 2025, if higher than DCFTA quota, five twelfths of 1.7.2021-31.12.2023 average
