

## 02 EXAMPLES OF THE MAIN CHALLENGES IN SERBIA

Small and fragmented holdings (average farm size of 6.2 ha).



Rural areas experience unfavourable population trends in comparison to urban areas (decline of rural population by 10.9% between 2002-2011, resulting in the share of 40.6% in total population).

Lack of basic infrastructure and services in rural areas impacting the attractiveness of rural areas for living and investments and leading to a negative net migration.

A low adherence of agricultural producers to environmentally sound practices resulting in inadequate management of manure and of usage of pesticides and fertilisers.




