The fruits are distributed on the 5 weekdays. | Supply: The schools are supplied at least once per week, and around 20\% of the schools are supplied twice a week, depending on the quantities needed. Distribution: The distribution frequency to kids depends on the internal organisation of each school. (For 2020-2021 the participating schools had self-reported that 27.2\% would distribute milk/milk products on 1 day/week: $7.4 \%$ on 2 days/week: 4.9\% on 3 days/week: $6.25 \%$ on 4 days/week: and $54.3 \%$ on 5 days/week (a school week is equal to 5 days /week)) |
