- The **new system of vine authorisations**:
 - Aims to support increase in competitiveness, while preventing excessively quick increase in vine plantings
 - Will run from 2016 until 2030, be more open and less restrictive than the planting rights regime
 - Instead of "*prohibition of vine plantings*", 1% increase of new plantings/year, with a possibility for MS where justified to establish lower limits at national or PDO (e.g. *Porto, Champagne*) level.
 - Authorisations with no cost to producers, and non-transferable
 - Rules on replantings and conversion of planting rights into authorisations
- Wine will remain only EU-sector with a quota system after 2017

Implementation by MS

Main steps for granting an autorisation:

- By 1 March: MS make public the percentage of area available, allocation method, eligibility and priority criteria, area restrictions, ...
- By 1 May: submission of applications
- By 1 August: granting the autorisation
- (By 1 November: notif. to the Commission of granted areas).

Replantings:

- Applications at any time during the same wine year of grubbing up
- Granting by MS automatically within 3 months
- Possibility of area restrictions (PDO/PGI).



- (1) The applicant shall have an area which is not smaller than the area for which he requests the authorisation"; Art 64(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013
- (2) The applicant shall possess adequate occupational skills and competence"; Art 64(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013
- (3) The application shall not pose a significant risk of misappropriation of the reputation of specific protected designation of origin;
- (4) The application shall not pose a significant risk of misappropriation of the reputation of specific protected geographical indication;
- (5) Where duly justified, one or more of the criteria referred to in paragraph 2, provided that they are applied in an objective and non-discriminatory manner; Art 64(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013
