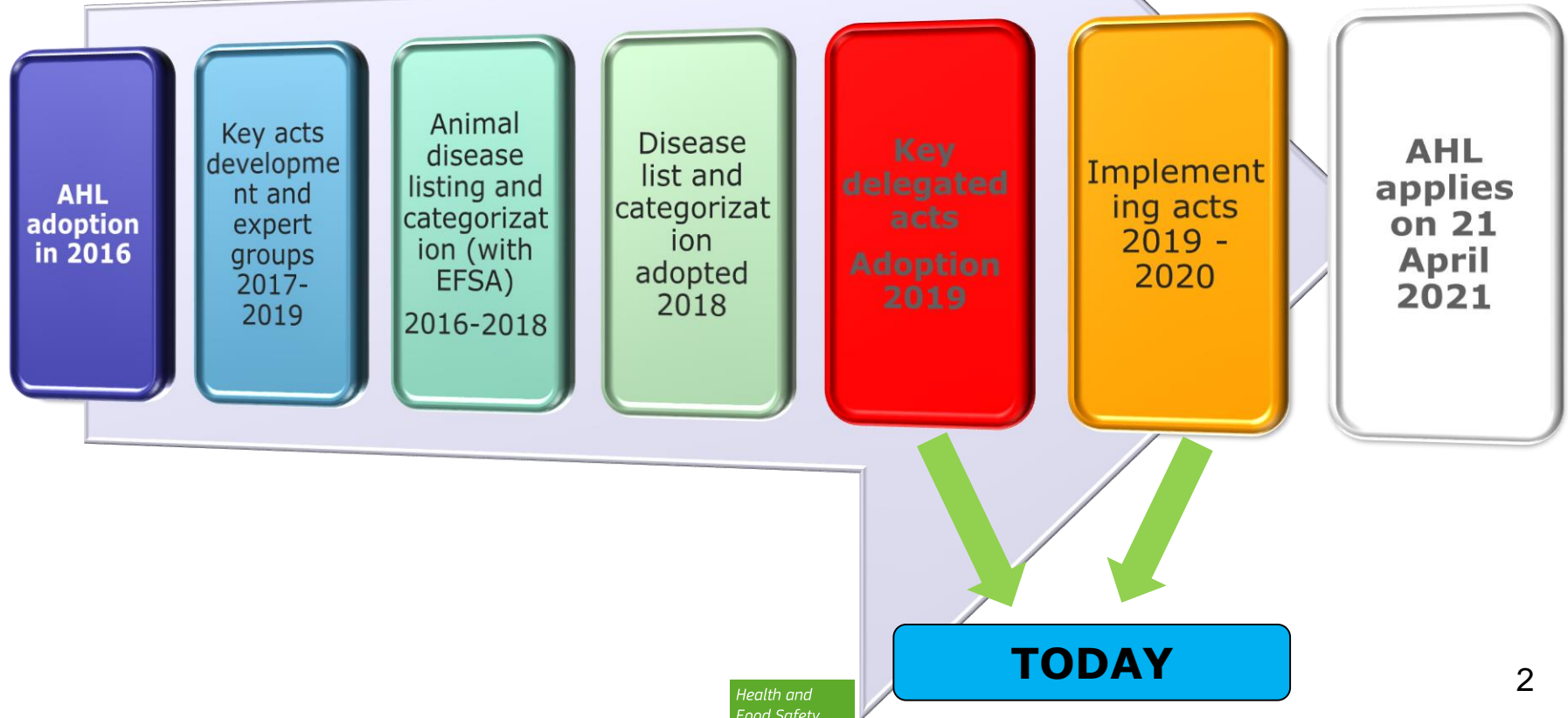

Delegated Act on establishments and Traceability

- **AHL sets out an obligation to register**
 - Establishments keeping terrestrial animals
- **This DA sets the**
 - Means and methods of identification
 - Data bases
 - Movement documents (within MS)

- **Basic rule**

- **Derogation:**

- No ID within MS for movements within supply chain - permission by MS**

- 'supply chain' means an integrated production chain of a **common health status** as regards listed diseases consisting of a collaborative network of specialised establishments **approved by the competent authority**, between which porcine animals **are moved** to complete the production cycle*

- **Exemption and special rules:**

- porcine kept for cultural or scientific (or hobby) purposes- permitted by MS





Data bases-Movement document

- **Data bases-CA should store:**
 - **For establishments**
 - Unique registration number
 - Name and address of the operator
 - **For each movement**
 - Number of animals
 - Unique registration number of establishment of origin and destination
 - Date of arrival and departure
- **Movement document (within a MS)**
 - Should accompany the animals and
 - Should contain the relevant information described above
 - Registration number of the means of transport
