



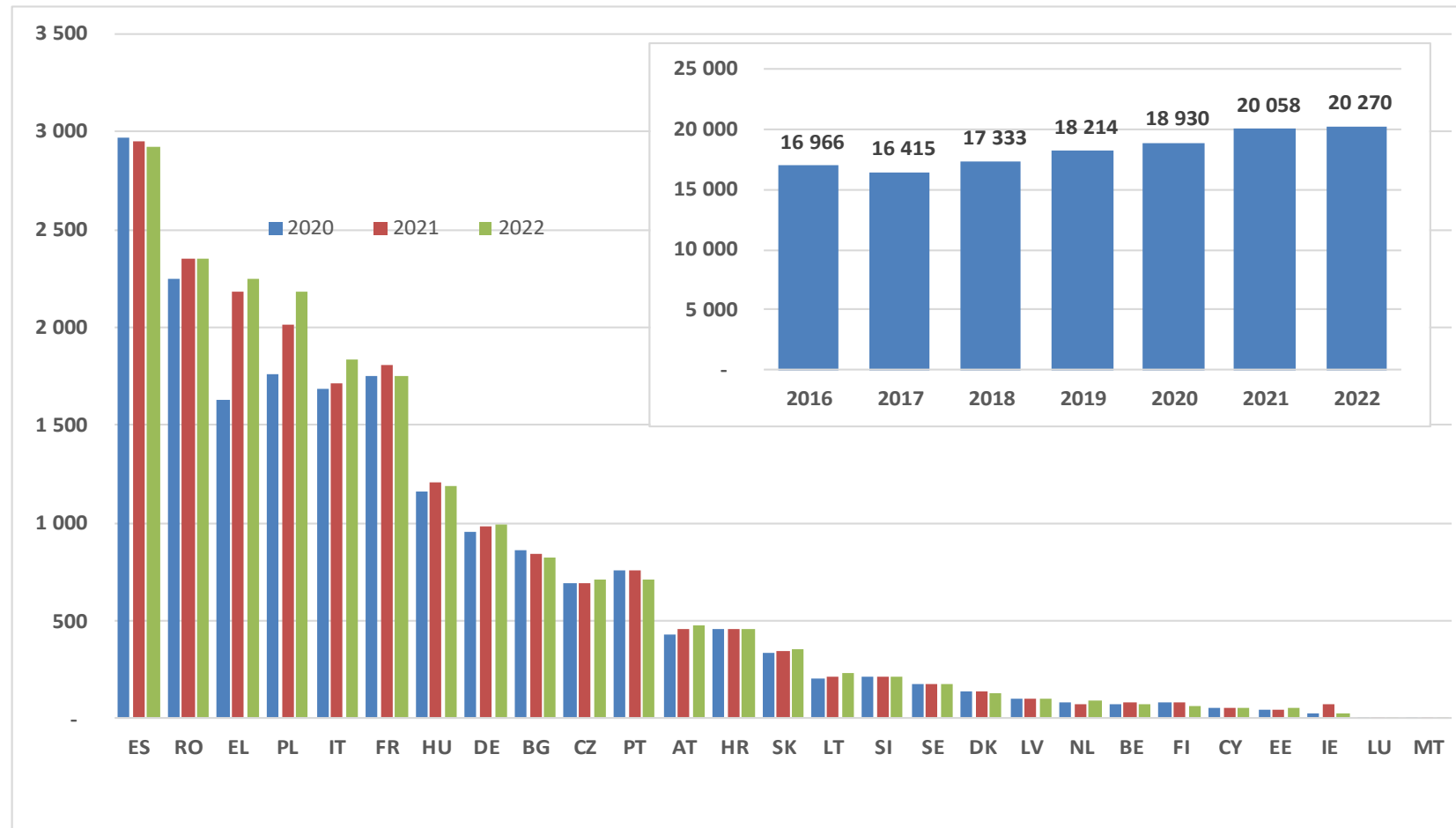

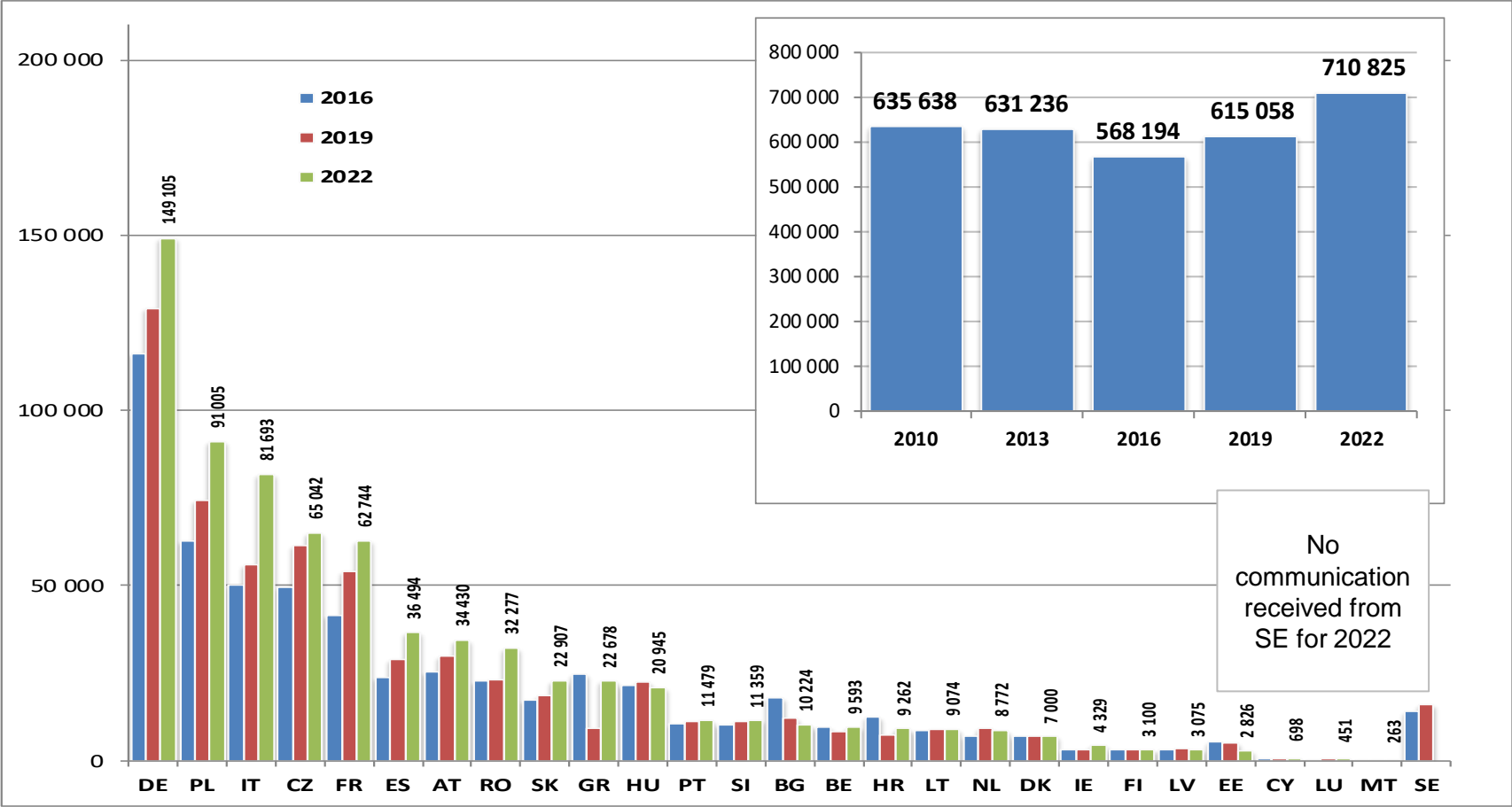
Evolution of the number of hives (in thousand)

Evolution of the number of beekeepers

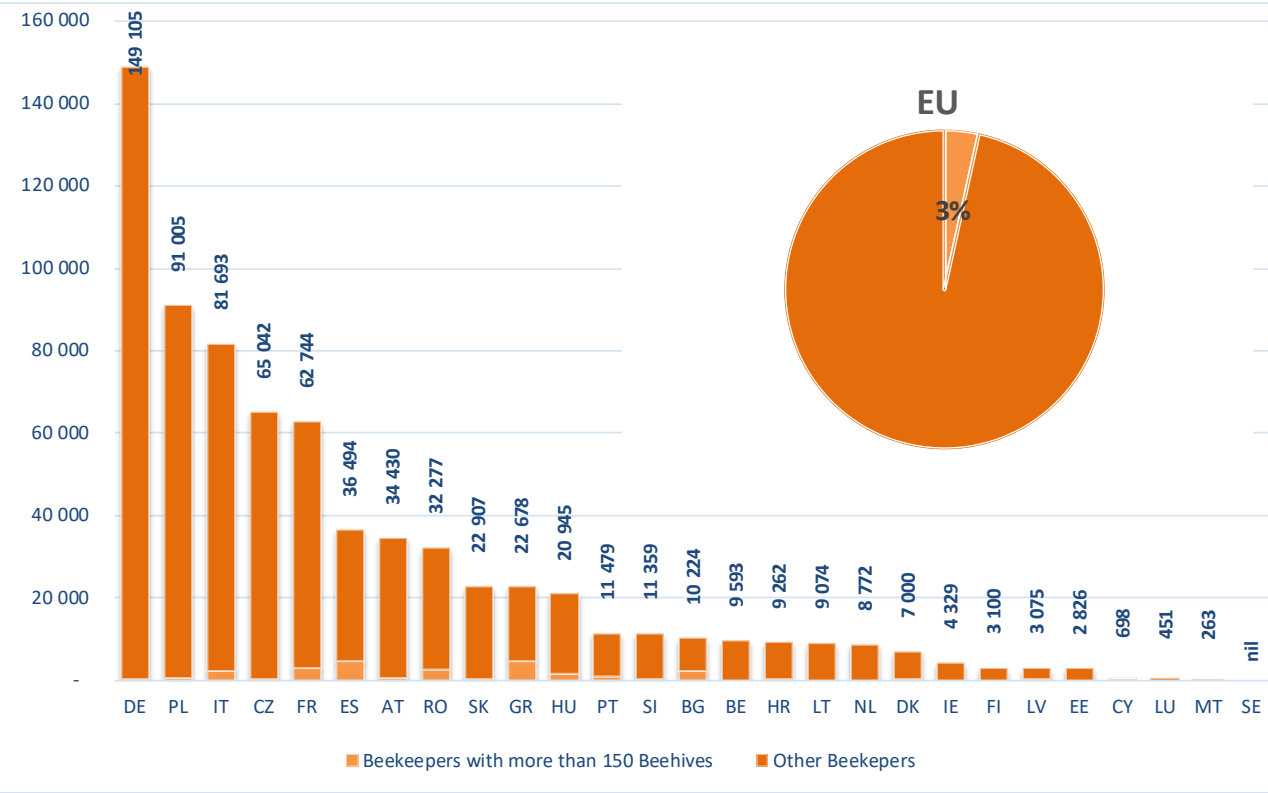

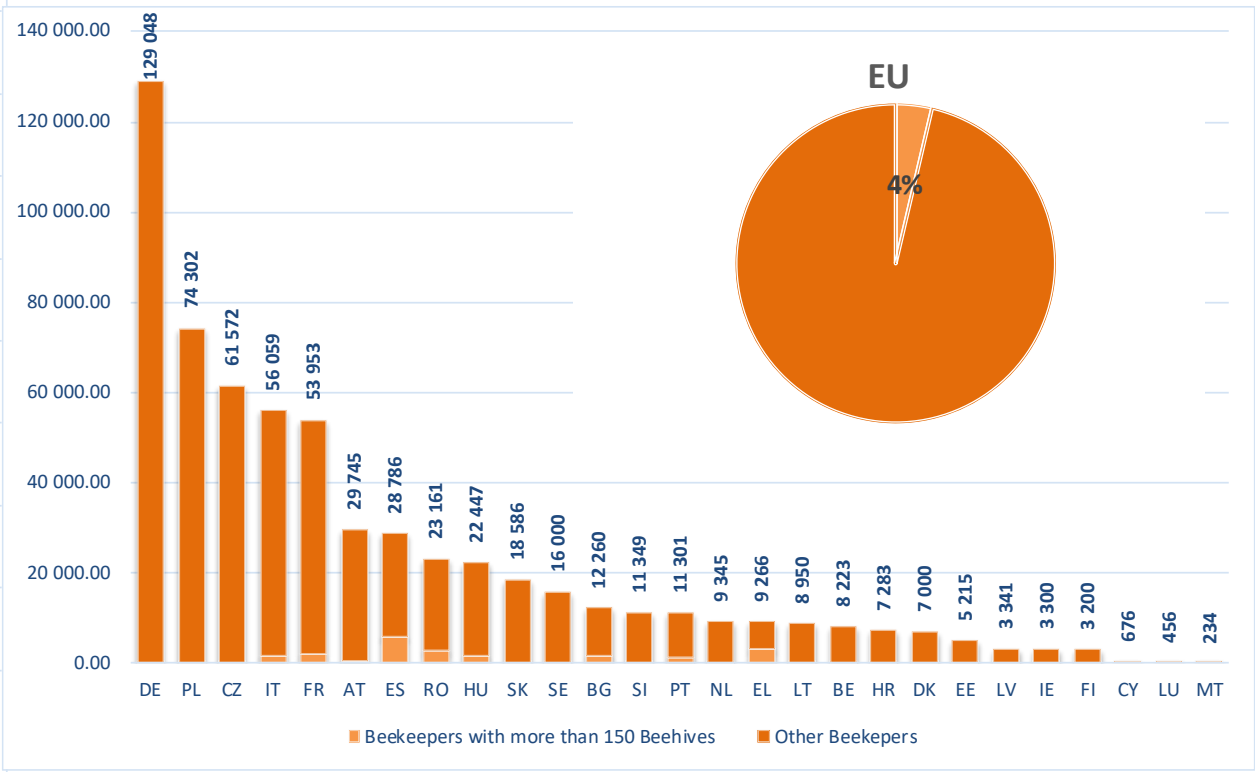
Share of beekeepers with more than 150 beehives



Share of beekeepers with more than 150 Beehives (2022)

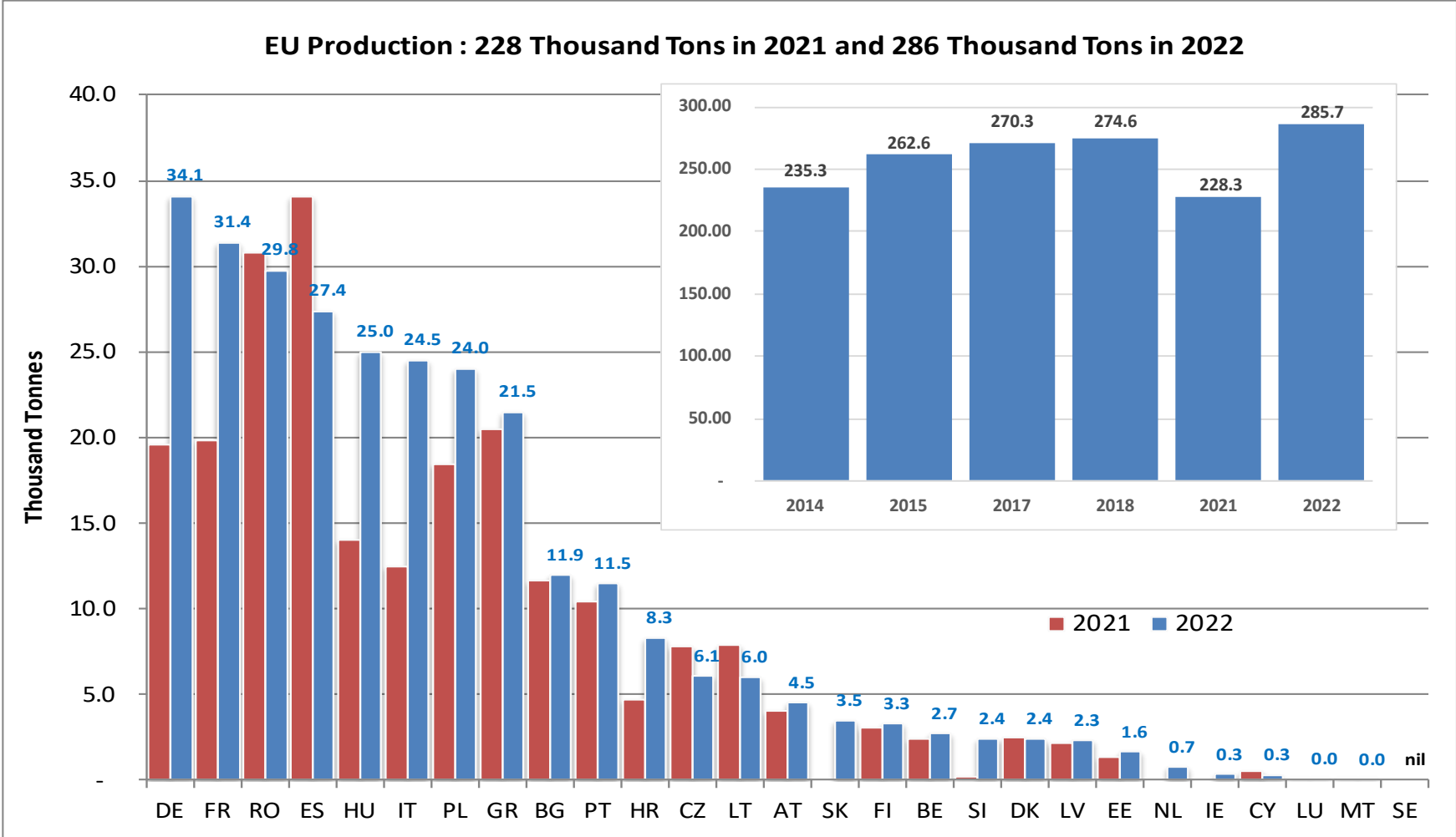


Share of beekeepers with more than 150 Beehives (2018)

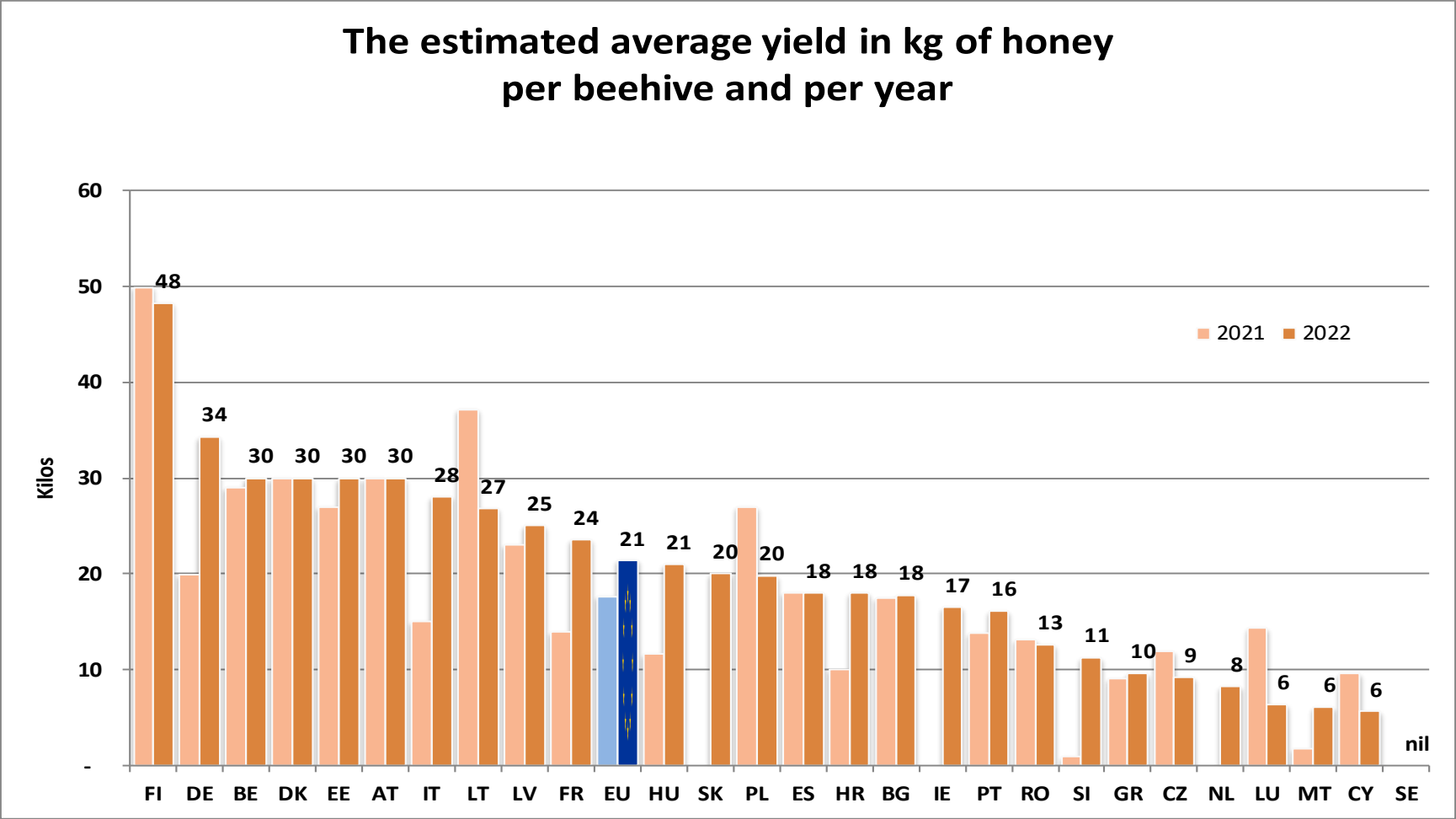
EU Honey Production

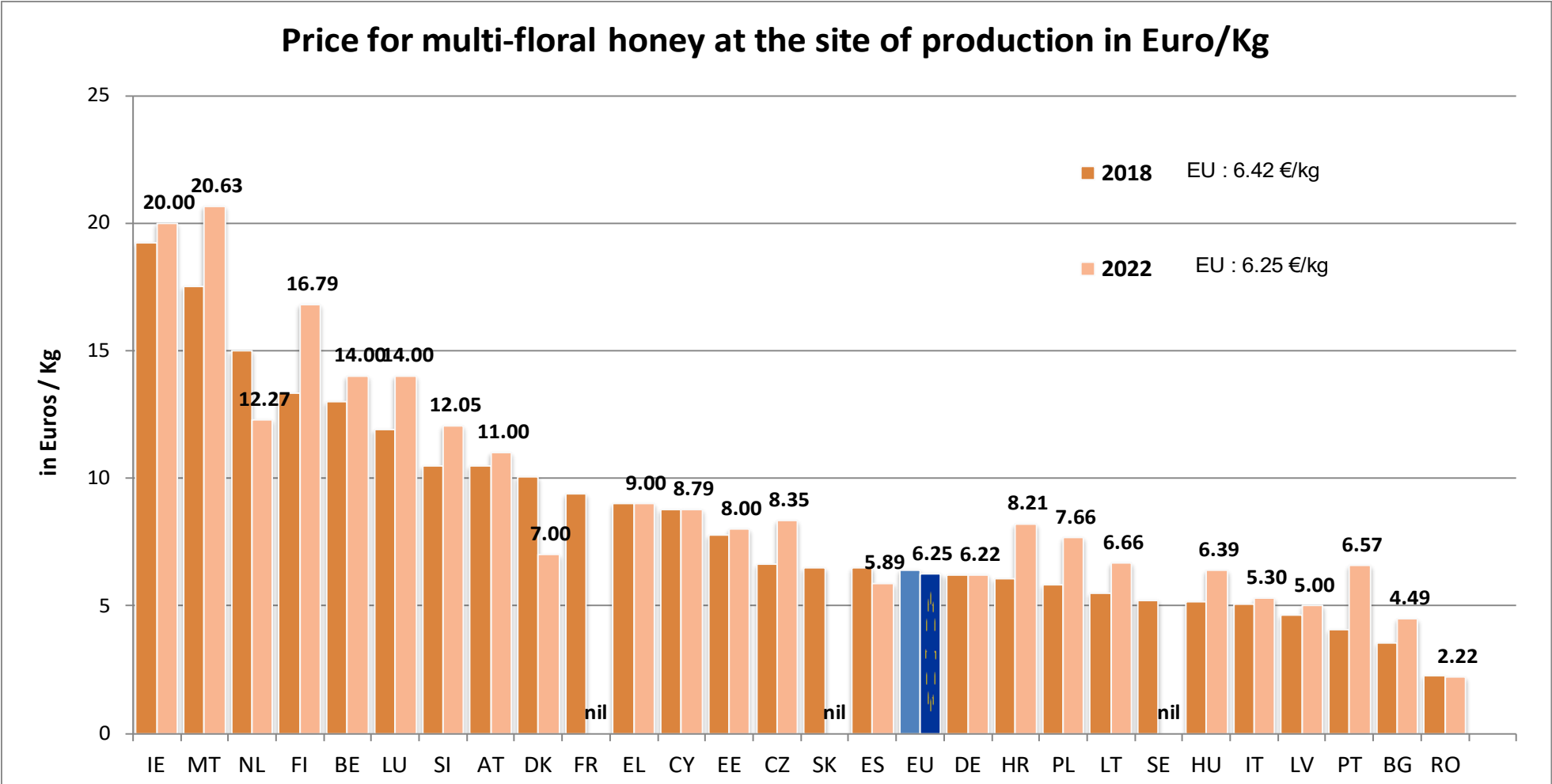
Estimated yield per beehive

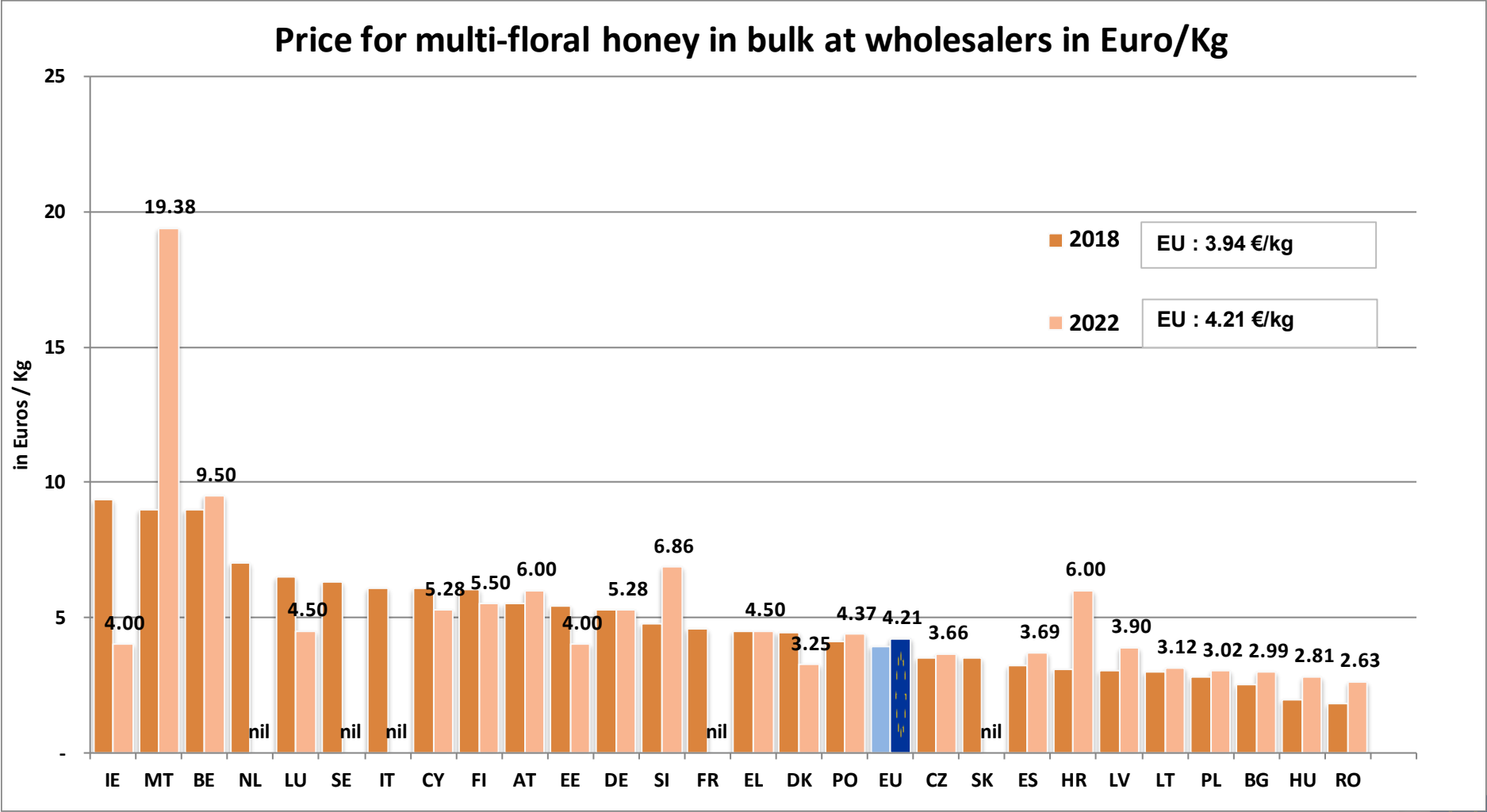
Honey price at production site

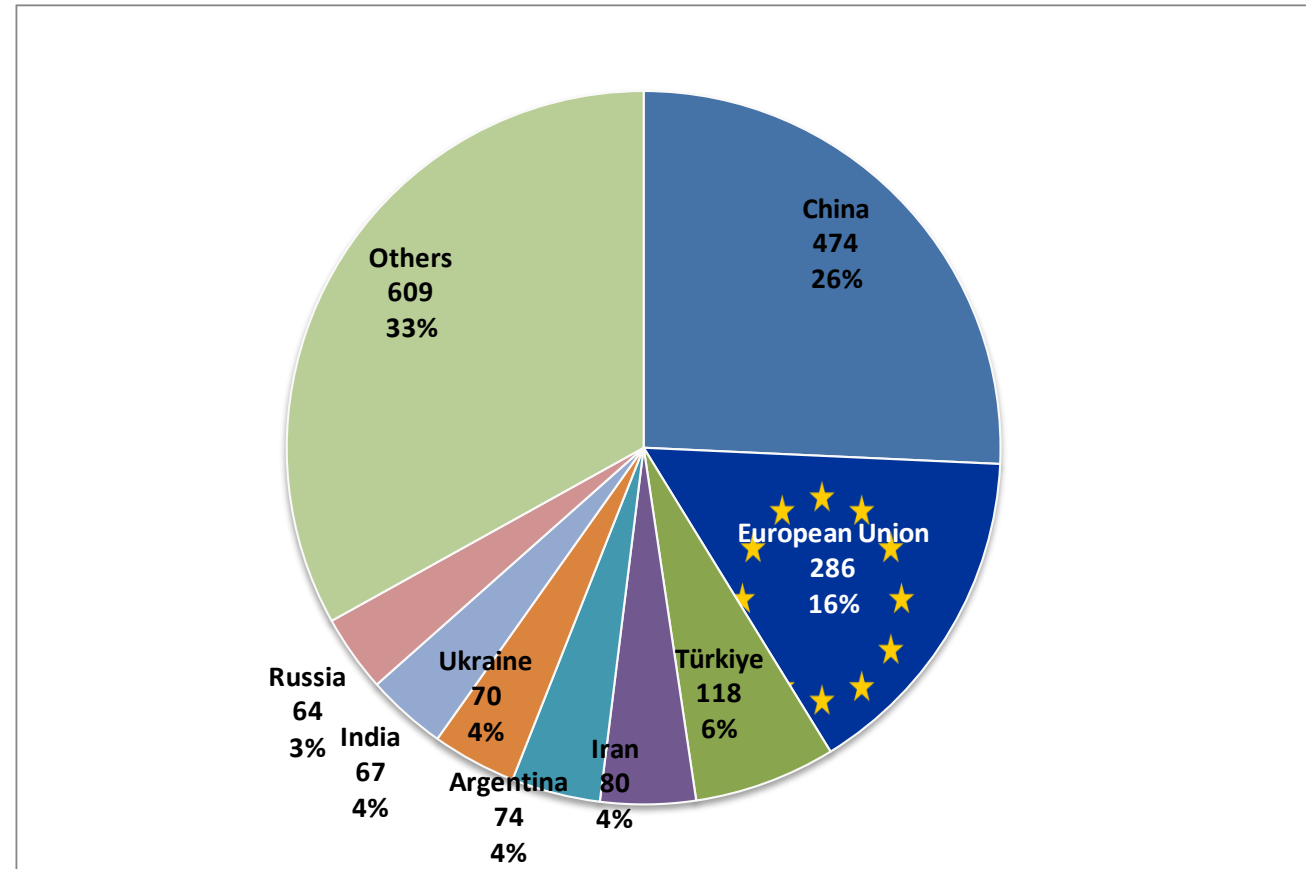

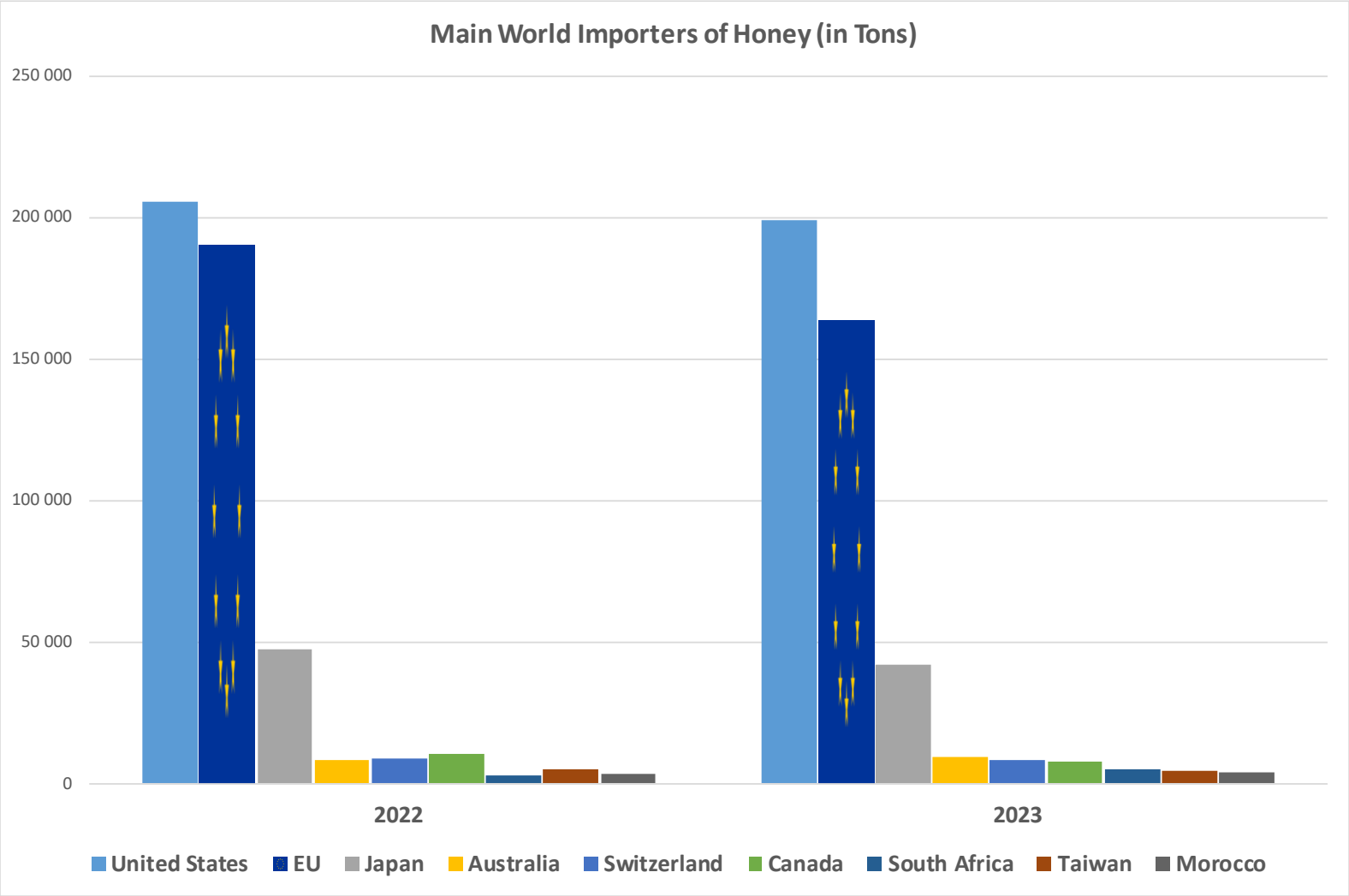

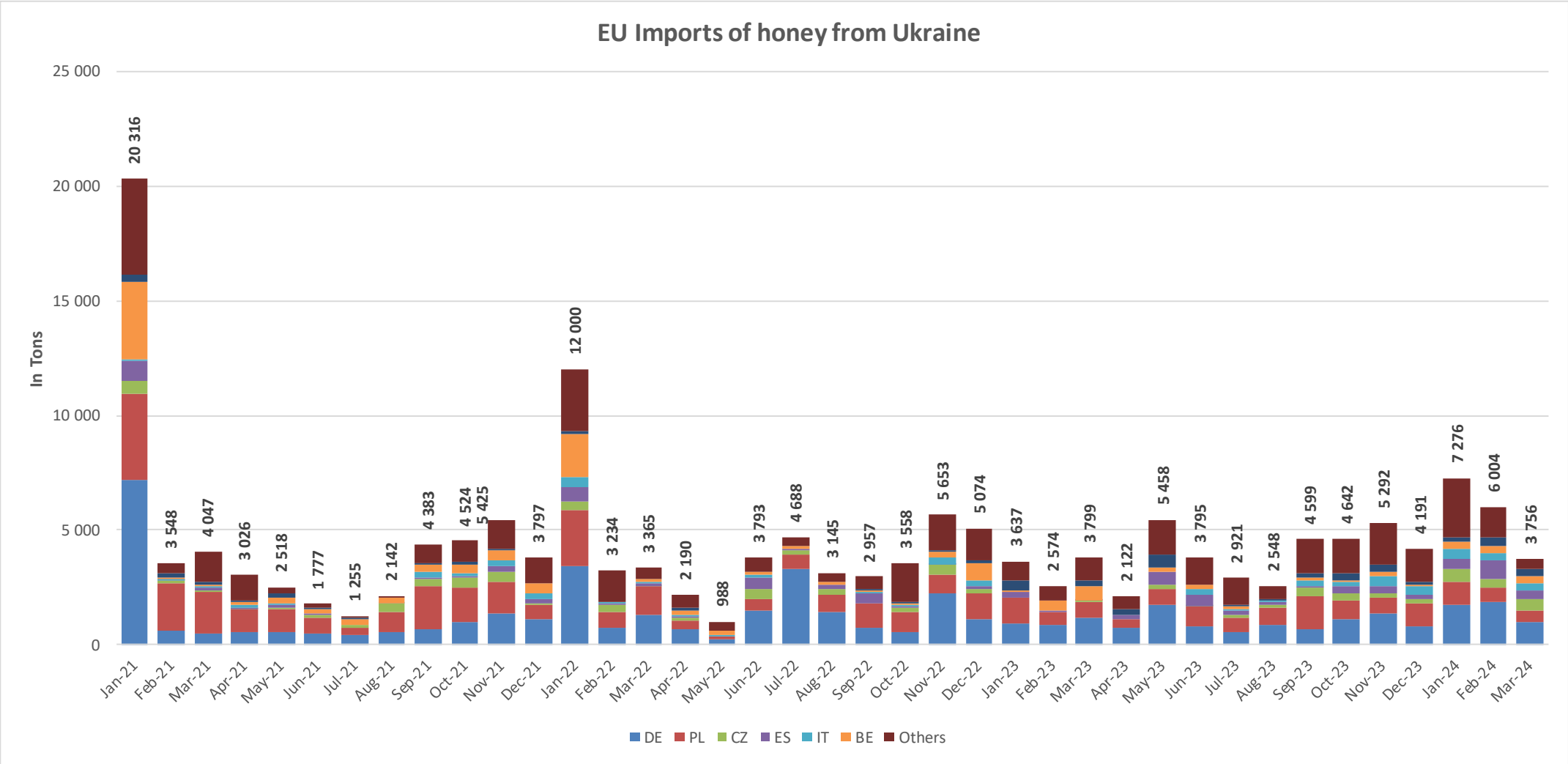

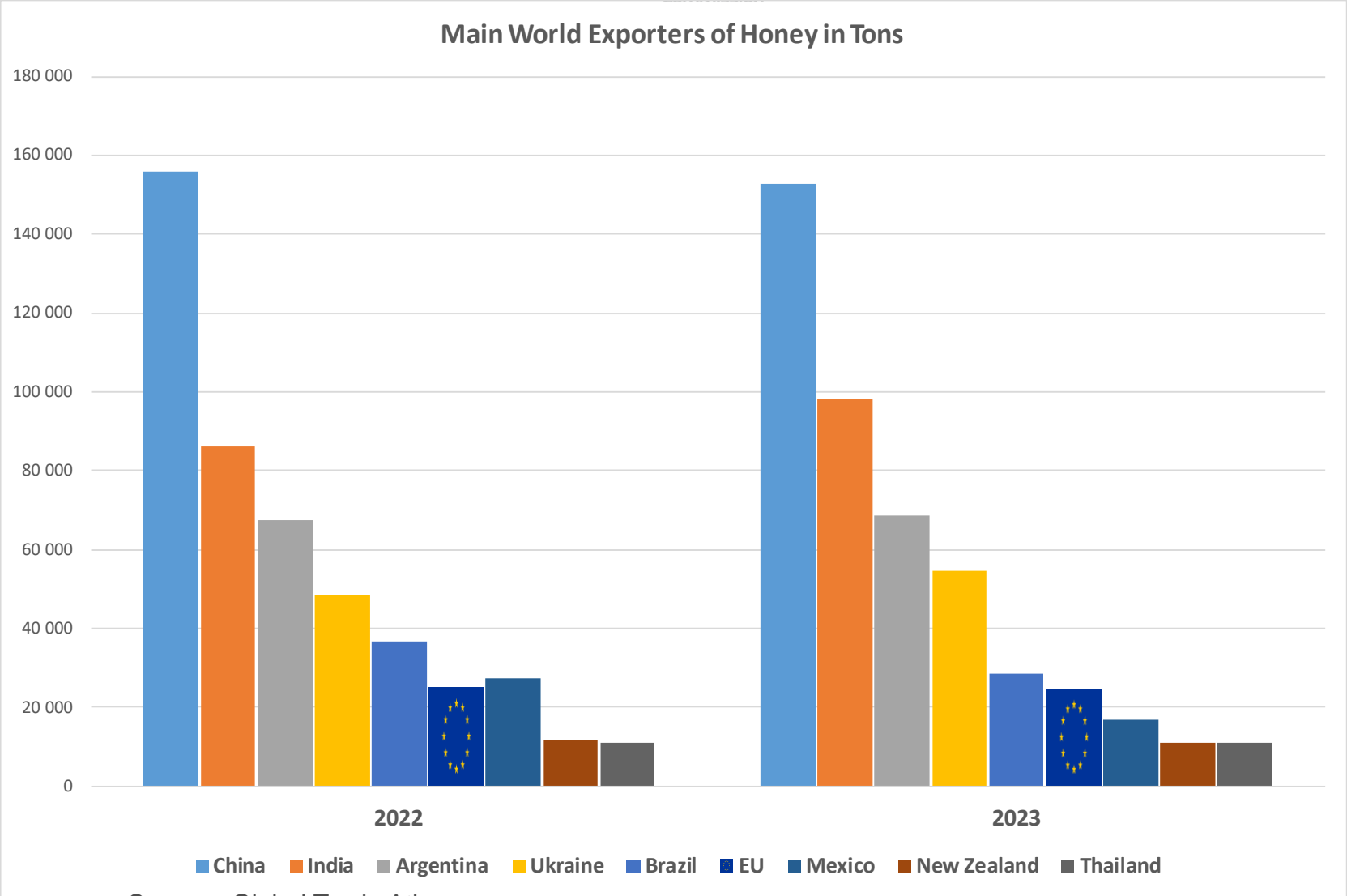

Summary of EU honey market situation (1)



- EU remains second world producer (~285 000 tons, 2022) after China
- EU honey production increased in 2022 compared to 2021 harvest
- Longer term increase in number of beehives slowed down (20,3 millions, 2022)



Summary of EU honey market situation (2)



- EU remains only ~63% self-sufficient in honey
- Imports needed to cover EU domestic consumption
- China and Ukraine remain key suppliers
- EU honey trade balance keeps largely negative: Imports>Exports
