The synthesis presented in this document reflects the content of Member States' notifications available to the Commission services as they stood on 01 April 2022.

It is made available without prejudice to any finding in respect of their compliance with the regulatory framework.

1. VOLUNTARY COUPLED SUPPORT IN A NUTSHELL

Member States may use up to a maximum percentage of their annual national ceiling for direct payments to finance **voluntary coupled support** (VCS) (Chapter 1 of Title IV of Regulation (EU) No 1307/2013 of the European Parliament and the Council ('the basic act' hereafter)).

Member States may only decide to grant VCS to a list of sectors and productions¹ in sectors or regions, where specific types of farming or specific agricultural sectors particularly important for economic, social or environmental reasons undergo certain difficulties. Coupled support is a production-limiting scheme that shall take the form of an annual payment based on fixed areas and yields or on a fixed number of animals and shall respect financial ceilings to be determined by Member States for each measure and notified to the Commission (Article 52(6) of the basic act).

Each Member State may only use a limited part of its national ceiling for direct payments to grant VCS. This **budgetary limit** is 8+2%, which, under certain conditions, may be increased to 13+2%. Further increase is possible only if certain specific needs require so, in which case the decision of the Member State is also subject to approval by the European Commission.

The Member States could apply VCS as from claim year 2015. They may review their support decisions on an annual basis.² The notifications for CY2022 were due by 1 August 2021.

2. VCS DECISIONS FOR CLAIM YEAR 2022 - OVERVIEW

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions' as from claim year 2015, 27 Member States (i.e. all Member States³ except for DE) decided to apply VCS from claim year 2015. Due to the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union, this number decreased to 26 (i.e. all Member States except for DE) as from claim year 2020, which remains unchanged for claim year 2022.
- Number of support measures: The number of measures has fluctuated between 250 and 260 since 2015, with 260 measures in claim year 2022.
- Budget: The annual monetary allocation has been, and remained after this review, around **EUR 4.2 billion per year**. This represents 11.2% of the direct payments budget.
- Support distribution per sector: The three animal-based sectors have always been, and also remained after this review, the largest VCS beneficiaries, receiving 72.9% of all coupled support allocations. The most important area-based beneficiaries are protein crops (11.3%), fruits and vegetables (4.5%), and sugar beet (4.3%).



As from claim year 2019. Previously, the basic act allowed a single review by 1st August 2016 with application as from claim year (CY) 2017.



Member States' overview – comparison of support decisions from CY2021 to CY2022:

- **17 Member States** (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, and Sweden) decided to modify their previous support decisions.
- 9 Member States (Austria, The Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Ireland, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, and Slovenia.) left their previous support decisions fully unchanged. NB: Germany maintained its former decision not to grant VCS.

3. OVERVIEW FOR THE MAIN SECTORS

3.1 Beef and veal sector

VCS decisions in general⁴:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions' notified for CY2015, 24 Member States decided to grant coupled support for beef and veal as from claim year 2015. This number decreased to 23 Member States from claim year 2017 and (due to Brexit) further to 22 Member States in claim year 2020, which remained unchanged since then.
- Number of support measures (EU27): In comparison to the former support decisions, it decreased from 54 to **52 measures** in claim year 2020, which remained unchanged since then
- Budget: The sector's monetary allocation (EU27) only slightly increased by 0.05% from EUR 1 626 million in claim year 2021 to EUR 1 627 million in claim year 2022.

The beef and veal sector has always been, and remains for claim year 2022, the biggest VCS beneficiary; its share in the total VCS budget reaches **almost 39%**. This represents **4.3%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It remained roughly stable at around 19.3 million heads for years.
 It decreased to 18.9 million heads in claim year 2020 and slightly increased (to 19.0 million) in 2022.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2022, the average support rate remained around 86
 EUR/head.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2021:

- New/deleted measures: The list of measures remained unchanged since 2021.
- Modified measures: In 2022, 12 Member States (Belgium, Croatia, Denmark, Finland, France, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden) carried out modifications of already existing measures. 5 of these adjusted the eligibility conditions (HR, DK, FI, LT, RO), two the fixed number of animals (DK, RO) and 9 the financial envelopes/unit rates (BE, ES, FR, HR, PL, PT, SK, FI and SE in most cases this was a smaller, necessary adjustment due to the change of the direct payments budget and thus the total amount available for VCS).

3.2 Milk and milk products sector

VCS decisions in general⁵:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 19 Member States decided to grant coupled support for the milk and milk products sector as from claim year 2015. Except for a short period with only 18 MS in 2017 and 2018, this remained at the same level since then.
- Number of support measures (EU27): It was 31 till 2019, grew to **32 measures** in 2020, and remained unchanged since then.

 Budget: The sector's monetary allocation (EU27) increased by 0.47% from EUR 892 million in claim year 2021 to EUR 896 million in claim year 2022.

The milk and milk products sector has always been, and also remained after the review for claim year 2022, the 2nd biggest VCS beneficiary (after the beef and veal sector). Its share from VCS slightly increased to **21.4%** (EU27). This represents around **2.4%** of the annual national ceiling for direct payments.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It remained unchanged since 2021 at the level of 11.5 million heads.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2022, the average support rate remained around 78
 EUR/head (same level as in 2021).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- New/deleted measures: The list of measures remained unchanged since 2021.
- Modified measures: In 2022, 12 Member States (Belgium Wallonia, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Finland, France, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, and Spain) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (FI, HR, CY), the modulation model (HR) and the financial envelopes/unit rates (BE-Wallonia, BG, HR, FR, LV, LT, PL, PT, SK, ES in most cases this was a smaller, necessary adjustment due to the change of the direct payments budget and thus the total amount available for VCS).

3.3 Sheep and goat meat sector

VCS decisions in general⁶:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 22 Member States
 decided to grant coupled support for the sheep and goat meat sector as from claim year 2015.
 After some fluctuation, it remained 21 Member States since 2021.
- Number of support measures (EU27): It has alternated between 35 and 36 since 2015, standing at **36 measures** since 2021.
- Budget: After marginal increase (+0.07%) compared to the last year, it stands at EUR 536 million in claim year 2022.

The sheep and goat meat sector has always been the 3rd biggest VCS beneficiary (after the beef and veal and the milk and milk products sectors), but with a budget share **slightly below 13%**, which represents around **1.4%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments, it is far below the allocation of the beef and dairy sectors.

- Fixed number of heads (EU27): It has remained stable at around 41,2-41.3 million heads since 2015.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2022, the average unit amount of support (EU27 average since claim year 2020) remained unchanged at **13 EUR/head** (since 2019).

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- New/deleted measures: No change since 2021.
- Modified measures: In 2022, 9 Member States (Belgium Wallonia, Croatia, Finland, France, Latvia, Lithuania, Portugal, Slovakia, and Spain) carried out modifications of already existing

measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR, FI, LT), and the financial envelopes/unit rates (BE-Wallonia, HR, FR, LV, PT, SK, ES).

3.4 Protein crops sector

To recall, apart from the possibility to support the protein crop sector from the baseline 8 / 13% VCS allocation, the Member States may also use and additional up to 2% top up dedicated to grant VCS to this sector. (Article 53(3) of the basic act).

VCS decisions in general⁷:

- Number of Member States: The number of Member States granting such support has always alternated between 15 and 16 since 2015. It stands at 16 Member States since claim year 2019.
- Number of support measures (EU27): Unchanged with **28 measures** as from claim year 2019.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked in claim year 2022 slightly (by 0.1%) increased to EUR 473 million compared to the previous year.

The protein crops sector has always been the 4th biggest VCS beneficiary (after the animal-based sectors) and the biggest area-based VCS beneficiary. Its share from VCS remained **slightly above 11%**, which represents some **1.3%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU28): It remained unchanged with **4.16 million ha**.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): After marginal decrease (1-2 EUR/ha) compared to former years, it remained at 114 EUR/ha since 2021.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged.
- Modified measures: In 2022, 6 Member States (Bulgaria, Croatia, France, Poland, Slovakia, and Spain) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR) and the financial envelopes/unit rates (BG, HR, FR, PL, SK, ES in most cases this was a smaller, necessary adjustment due to the change of the direct payments budget and thus the total amount available for VCS).

3.5 Fruit and vegetables sector

VCS decisions in general8:

- Number of Member States: In the framework of the 'original support decisions', 19 Member States decided to grant such coupled support from claim year 2015. This remained unchanged under the following reviews also including claim year 2022.
- Number of support measures (EU27): **54 measures** with no changes since claim year 2019.
- Budget: The amounts earmarked in claim year 2022 slightly (by 2.7%) increased to EUR 189.2
 million compared to the previous year.

The fruit and vegetables sector has always been, and also remains for claim year 2022, the 5th biggest VCS beneficiary and also the 2nd most important area-based beneficiary (after the protein

crops sector). Its share from VCS slightly increased to **4.5%**, which represents some **0.5%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU27): It remained unchanged with 720 994 ha in CY2022.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): After dropping to 255 EUR/ha in 2021, it reached again the 2020 level of 262 EUR/ha in 2022.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged.
- Modified measures: In 2022, 9 Member States (Bulgaria, Croatia, France, Latvia, Lithuania, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, and Spain) carried out modifications of already existing measures. These changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR), and the financial envelopes/unit rates (BG, HR, FR, LV, LT, PT, RO, SK, ES in most cases this was a smaller, necessary adjustment due to the change of the direct payments budget and thus the total amount available for VCS).

3.6 Sugar beet sector

VCS decisions in general9:

- Number of Member States: The 'original' 10 Member States increased to 11 Member States in claim year 2017, which remained unchanged ever since.
- Number of support measures (EU27): 12 measures remained unchanged since claim year 2019.
- Budget: In claim year 2022, small (0.2%) increase to EUR 181.0 million compared to the previous year.

The sugar beet sector has always been, and also remains for claim year 2022, the 6th biggest VCS beneficiary and also the 3rd most important area-based beneficiary. Its share from VCS remained at **4.3%**, which represents some **0.5%** of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments.

- Fixed area (EU28): No changes, it remained at 507 669 ha for claim year 2022.
- Per unit amount (prior estimate): In 2022, it slightly increased from the previous 356 EUR/ha (EU27 average since claim year 2020) to 357 EUR/ha.

Status of the measures in comparison to CY2020:

- **New/deleted** measures: The list of measures remained unchanged
- Modified measures: In 2021, 4 Member States (Croatia, Greece, Lithuania, and Spain) carried out
 modifications of already existing measures. The changes concerned the eligibility conditions (HR)
 and the financial envelopes (HR, EL, LT, ES in most cases this was a smaller, necessary
 adjustment due to the change of the direct payments budget and thus the total amount available
 for VCS).

4 Overview for the remaining sectors¹⁰

The 6 biggest VCS sectors represent 93% of all VCS allocations (EU27 average). The remaining 7% is covered by the remaining 15 sectors (i.e. 0.8% of the annual national ceiling for all direct payments).

In the framework of their 'original support decisions' as from claim year 2015, **14 Member States** decided to grant VCS for the benefit of one or more of the following sectors: cereals, oilseeds, grain legumes, flax, hemp, rice, nuts, starch potato, seeds, olive oil, silkworms and hops. Besides, no Member State decided to support the following sectors: short rotation coppice, dried fodder and cane & chicory. This does **not change** for claim year 2022.

The changes in CY 2022 concerned the financial envelopes (FR – cereals, starch potato, hemp, hops, seeds, rice; IT – cereals; LV – cereals, oilseeds; LT – seeds; PT – rice; RO – seeds, silkworms; Spain – rice, nuts, grain legumes). Besides, Greece changed the measurement unit for the fixed number of the VCS intervention for silkworms, from 'number of box' to 'kilogram of cocoons', thereby causing a change in the value of the fixed number and the estimated unit amount rate.
