## What is the Outlook about?

#### WE DO

- Projections that follow trends while policies remain unchanged within the period, in a given macroeconomic environment
- Markets' developments consider observed trends and the overall direction of changes driven by policies in place

#### WE DON'T DO

- Forecasting as real developments are more volatile, depending also on unexpected external shocks
- Impact assessments as such, but the Outlook is used in such assessments to assess policy options and to model scenarios

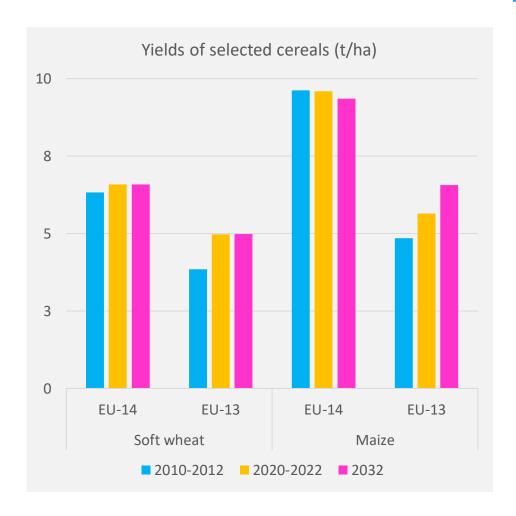








## EU outlook for crop market

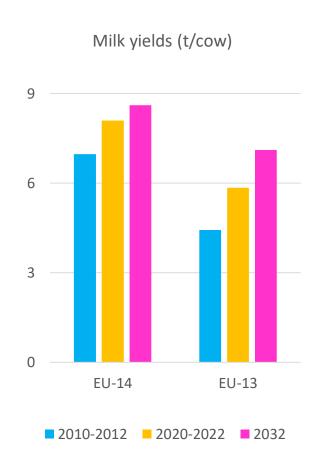


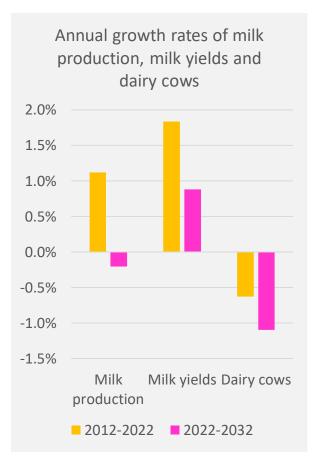
#### Cereals yields to stagnate:

- negative impacts of climate change
- reduced use of agricultural inputs
- move towards lower-yielding farming systems
- innovations and improved practices to counteract dampening effects



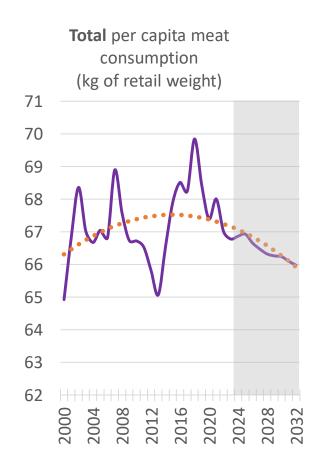
# EU outlook for milk and dairy products

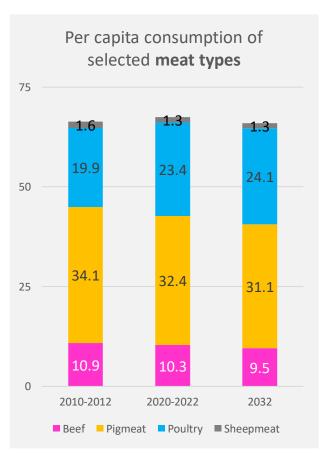




- Milk production to decline:
  - following structural decline in EU-14
  - reduced yield growth not to compensate fully for herd reduction
- Stable dairy consumption while export growth could slow down

#### EU outlook for meats

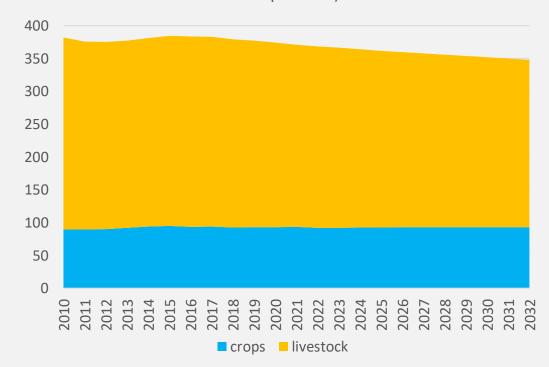




- Dietary changes reflected in meat consumption decline (in particular beef and pigmeat)
- Lower meat production in line with consumption trend and more sustainable production systems
- Exports of pigmeat to go down while other exports consolidate their net-trade position

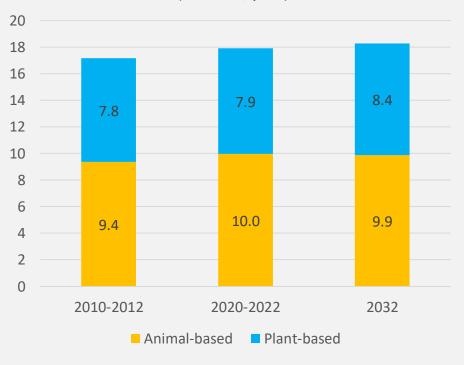
## EVOLUTION OF GHG EMISSION

GHG emissions per type of production (million t of CO2 equivalent)



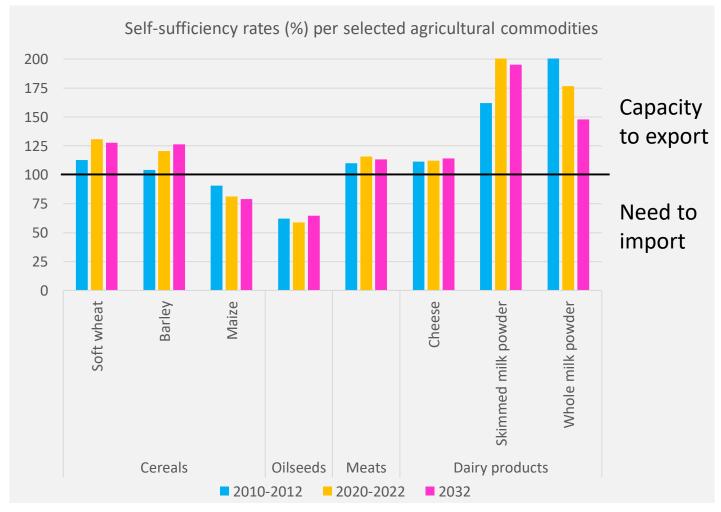
# EVOLUTION OF PROTEIN SUPPLY

## What about food self-sufficiency?



- Sustained self-sufficiency in wheat and barley
- Increasing self-sufficiency in oilseeds
- Meat and dairy selfsufficiency sustained
- The EU will reinforce its positive net trade position
- Still capacity to export

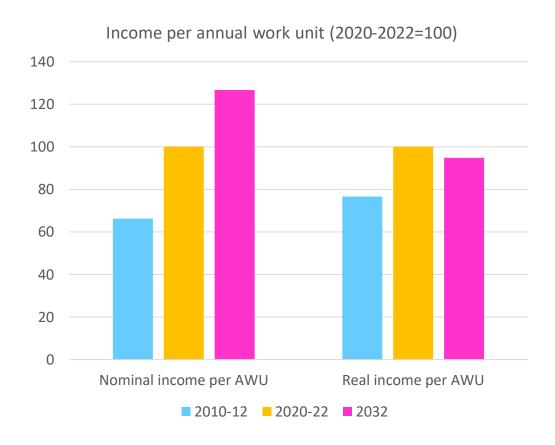
#### **MONITORING**

- Food supply (imports, self-sufficiency, import dependency, diversification of supplies)
  - Food security (food inflation, household spending on food, food and protein supply





### What about income?



- Value of agricultural production to remain stable
- Renewable and diversified energy supplies, energy-efficient practices and better-targeted fertilizer use to reduce the economic impact of high input costs
- Continuous labour outflow
- Income per worker to increase compared to 2012



# Take away messages

- EU agriculture is facing unprecedented challenges
- The Census 2020 shows a sector under pressure, with some positive stories
- Outlook is an important tool for market anticipation, impact assessment
- The 2022-2032 outlook:
  - Slowing down of yield and production growth; decline in milk production.
  - Meat consumption to decline, in particular beef
  - EU to remain broadly self sufficient for most agricultural products
  - Check the alternative scenarios!
