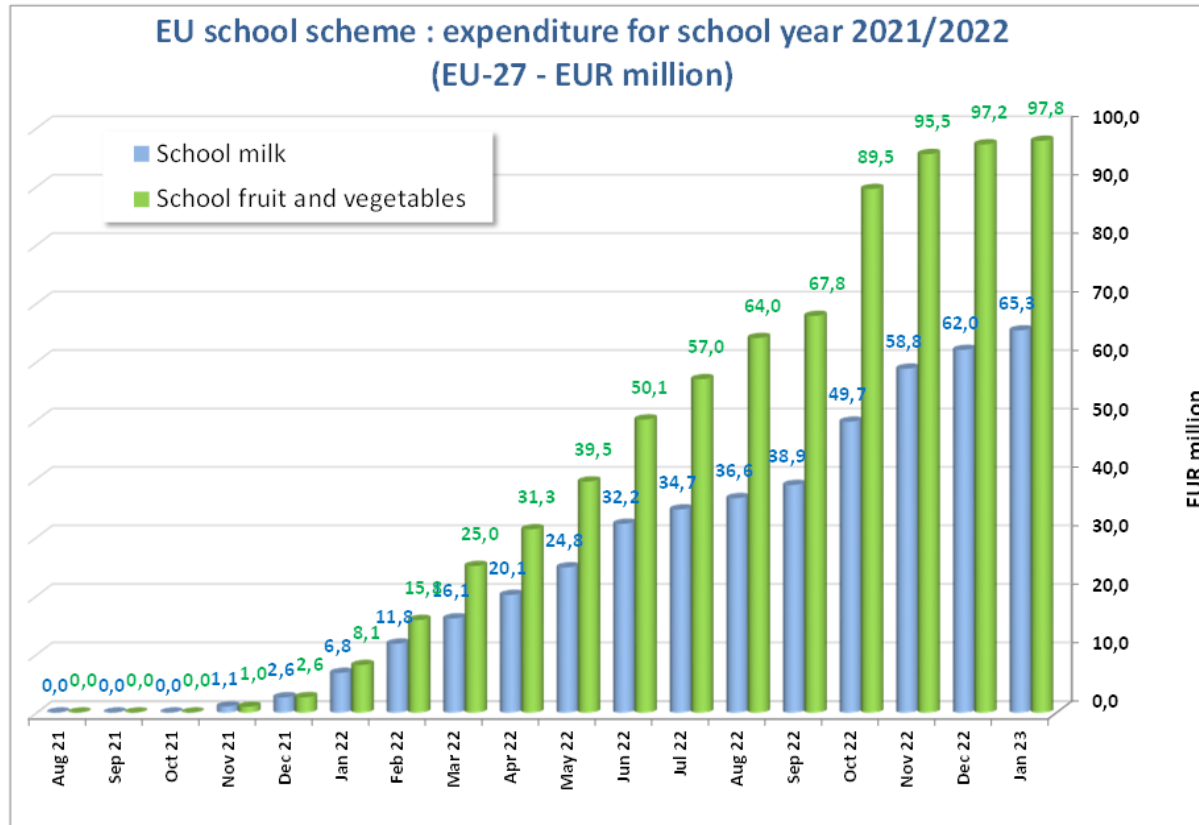

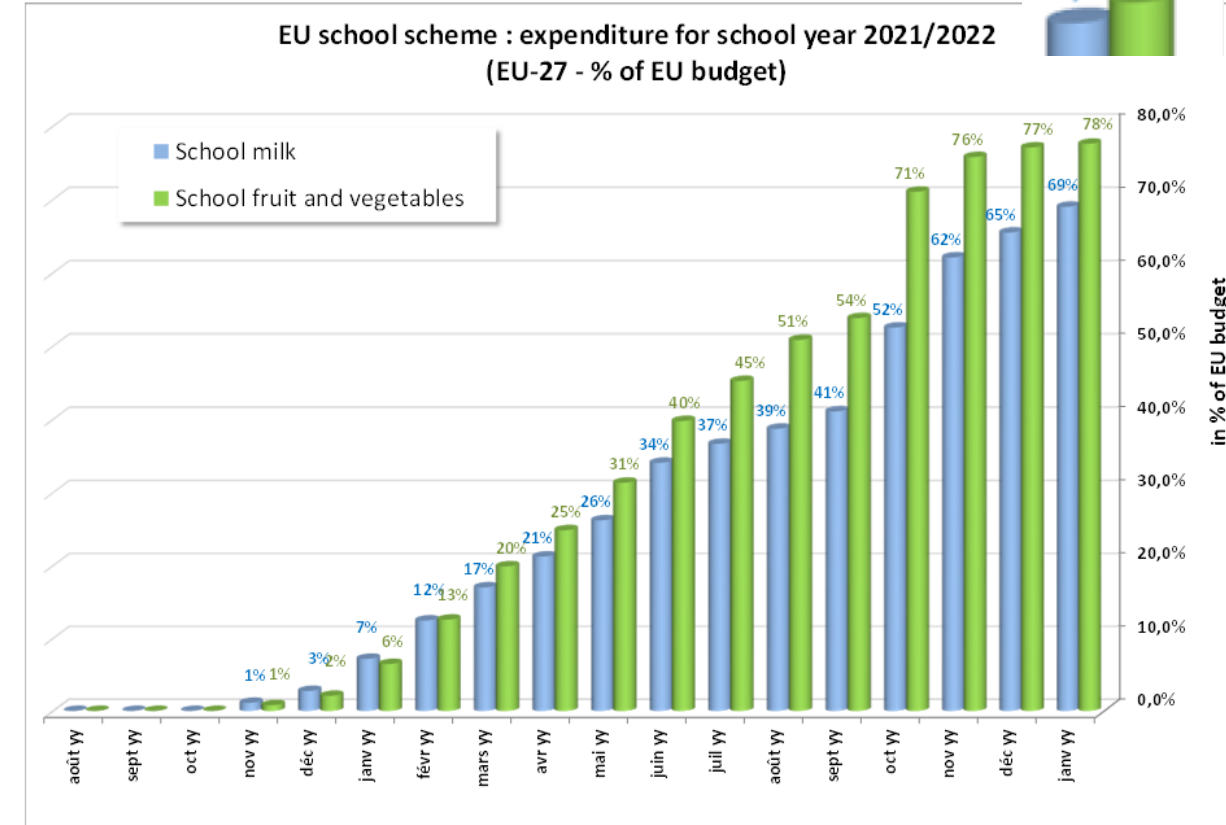

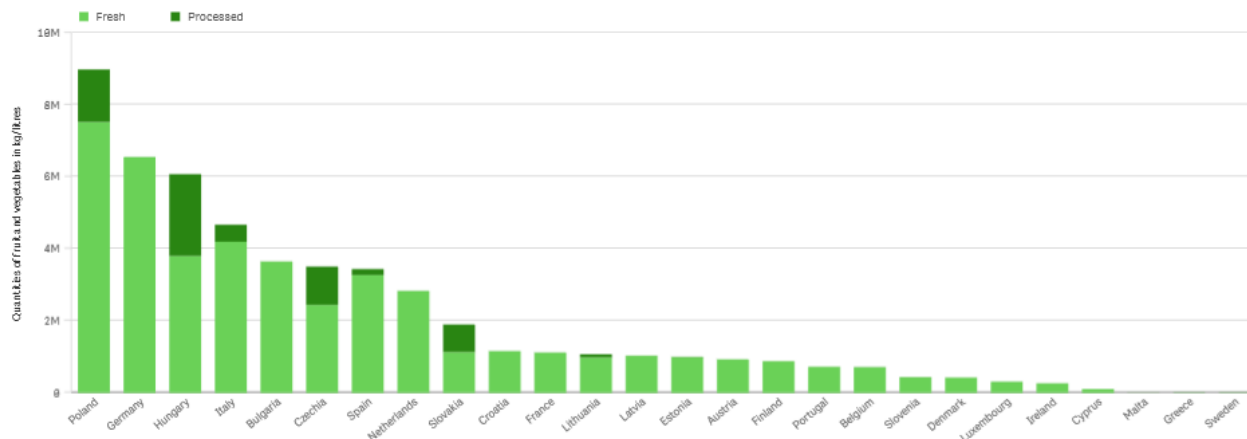

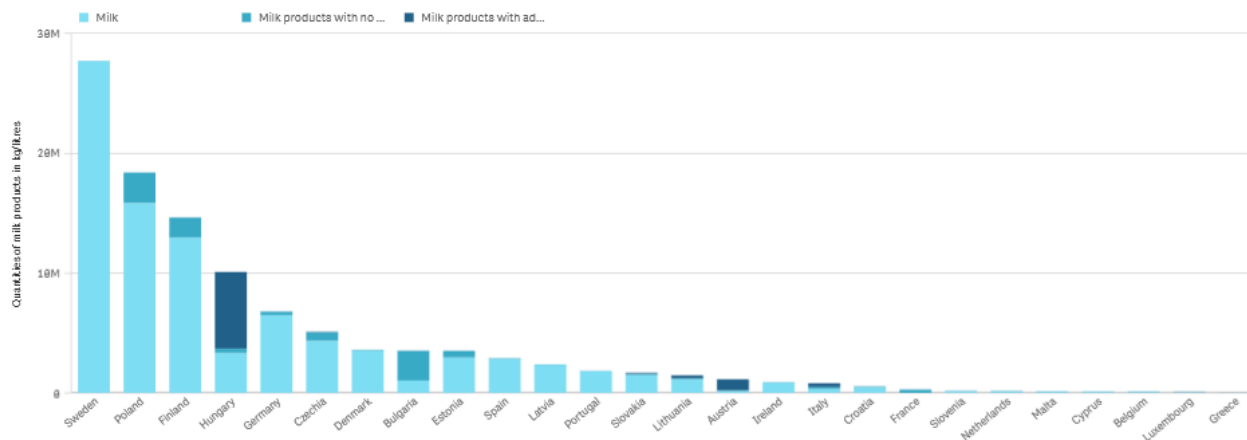

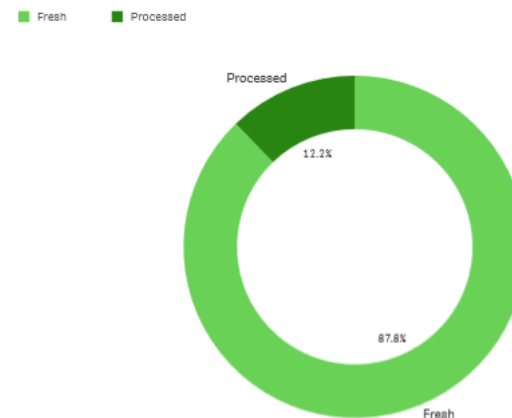
Quantities of fruit and vegetables supplied/distributed by Member State



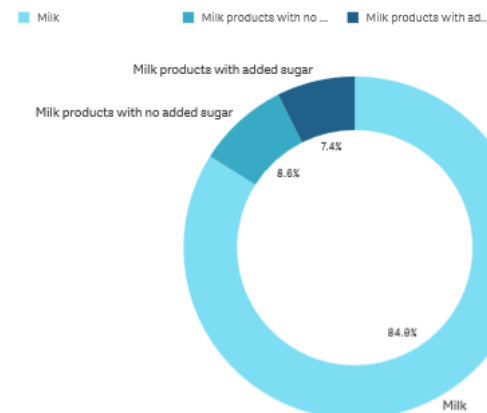
Quantities of milk products supplied/distributed by Member State



Quantities of fresh and processed fruit and vegetables supplied/distributed (%)

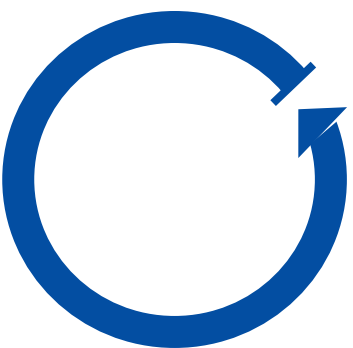


Quantities of milk products supplied/distributed by product (%)

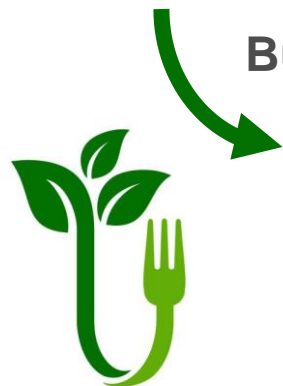

Standard cycle evaluation end 2023 – after 5 years of implementation

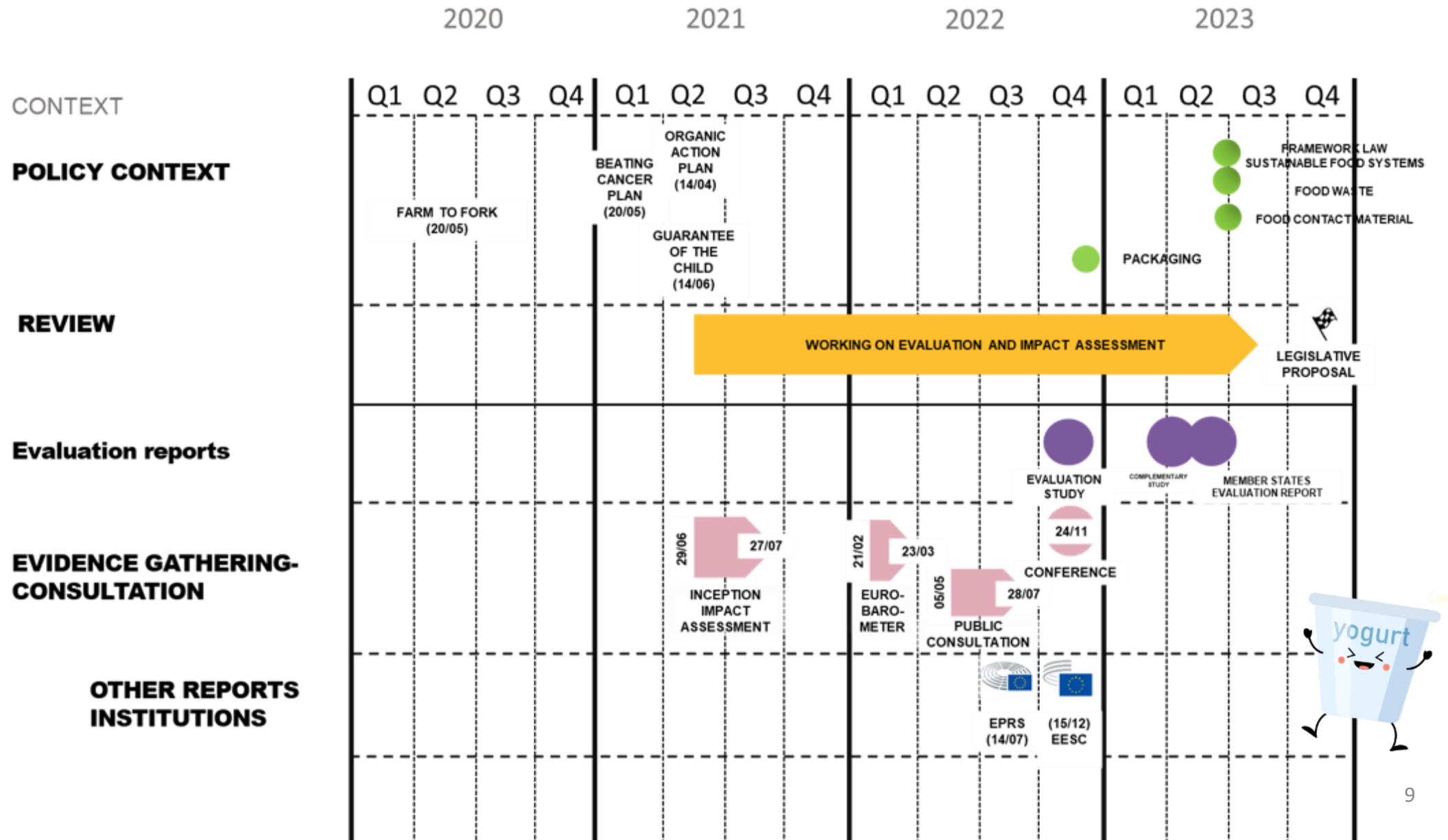


But ...
