



Development of GHG emissions in transport


Greenhouse gas emission in the EU in percentage change since 1990:



Road transport = 22% of total EU emissions




Projections for future erngy mix in tranport

Conclusion

- Renewable and low carbon fuels, including biofuels, have an important role to play to decarbonise transport modes that cannot be easily electrified.
- Contribution of biofuels from food and feed crops for decarbonisation is limited and their use for energy production should be minimized.
- Focus will be on promotion of advanced biofuels and other low carbon fuels, such as renewable electricity and renewable fuels of non-biological origin.
