

EU RICE MARKET CAN BE SUB-DIVIDED IN TWO DIFFERENT SEGMENTS:

JAPONICA RICE (short/medium grain) is the "traditional" European rice, representing ≈75% of EU rice production and mainly consumed in South Europe. For japonica rice, the EU is self-sufficient and is even a (small) net exporter.

INDICA RICE (long grain)

is the "traditional" Asian rice, representing ≈25% of EU rice production and mainly consumed in North Europe. For indica rice, the EU is not self-sufficient and is indeed a (big) net importer.



IN RECENT YEARS, EU rice market switched towards more EU production of japonica rice (short/medium grain) and more EU imports of indica rice (long grain).

EU RICE PRODUCTION

Total rice EU production: ≈ **3 Mio tonnes** of paddy rice ≈ **1.8 Mio tonnes** in milled rice equivalent

Total rice EU area:

≈ 425 000 ha (ie average yield of 7 tonnes/ha)

Rice is produced in 8 MS (IT, ES, EL, PT, FR, BG, RO, HU) with **Italy** representing **50%**

and **Spain 30%** of EU rice area and production



Rice is planted in May and **harvested in September** with marketing year for rice going from 1st September to 31st August.



EU RICE TRADE

EU IS NOT SELF-SUFFICIENT IN RICE (EU rice self-sufficiency ≈ 60%) and **needs to import** approx. **1.2 Mio tonne of milled rice/year** (mainly Indica/long grain rice) vs a EU production of 1.8 Mio tonnes and a EU domestic consumption of 2.8 Mio tonnes.



Production: ≈ 1.8 Mio tonnes **Imports**: ≈ 1.2 Mio tonnes

MAIN IMPORT ORIGINS

Cambodia (24%), India (21%), Thailand (18%)

MAIN IMPORT DESTINATIONS

UK (24%), FR (17%), BE (12%)

EU RICE DEMAND

Domestic use: ≈ 2.8 Mio tonnes **Exports**: ≈ 0.2 Mio tonnes

MAIN EXPORT ORIGINS

IT (50%), ES (15%), EL (10%)

MAIN EXPORT DESTINATIONS

Turkey (35%), Switzerland (≈10%), Lebanon (≈10%)

EU RICE PRICES

EU rice market prices vary significantly according

to the rice varieties but on average are close to

+/- 300 €/TONNE

for paddy rice (farmers level)



+/- 600 €/TONNE

for milled rice (industry level)

Japonica rice prices tend to be higher than Indica rice prices, in particular for certain premium quality varieties in Italy. (for which paddy rice prices can even exceed +/- 800 €/tonne at farmers level)

EU RICE IN THE WORLD

EU rice is not significant at global level (less than 1%) as illustrated with the following numbers:

≈ 500 Mio tonnes (milled eq.)

≈ 45 Mio tonnes (milled eg.)
