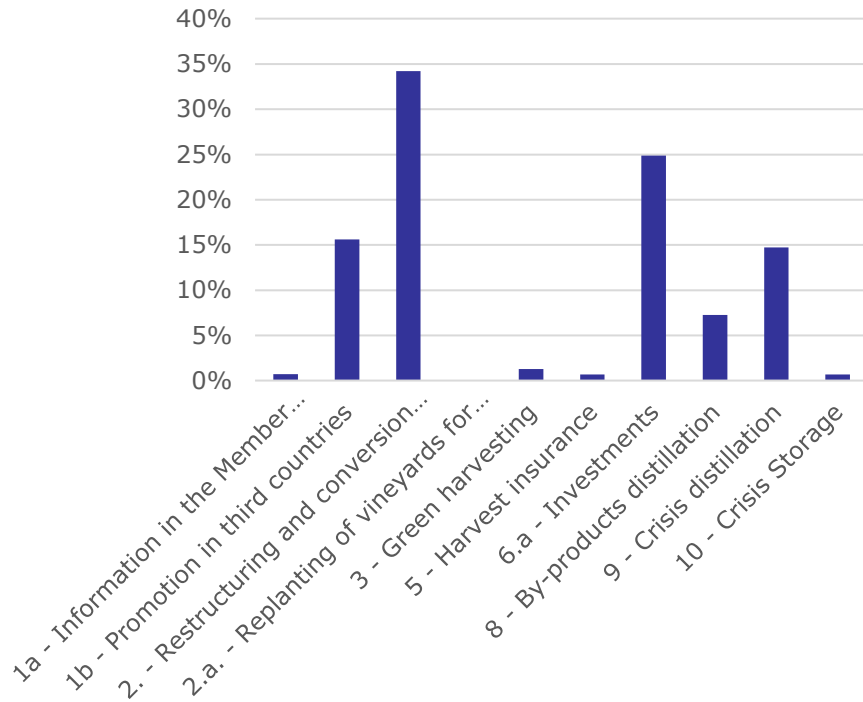

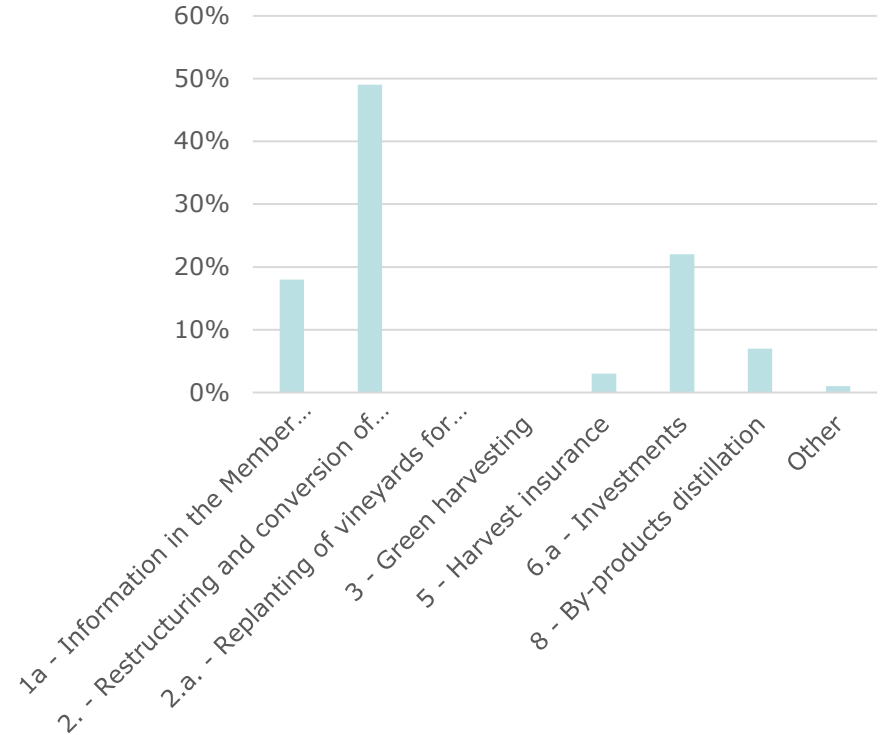

Lack of uptake for mutual funds and innovation

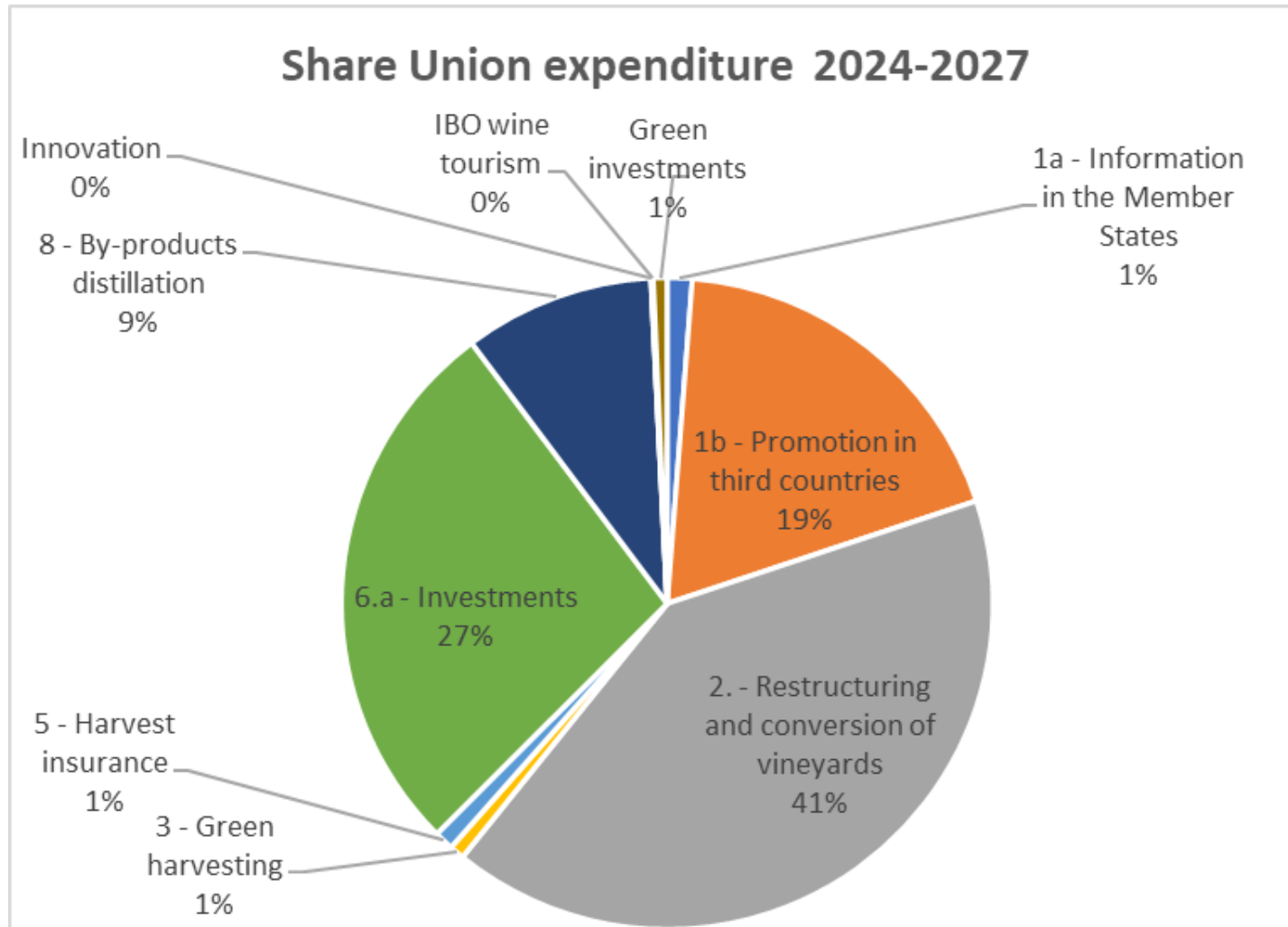
Restructuring down (normal evolution after application since 2008)
