## **EU financial support to Member States**

Since 2013, EU financial support has been provided to prevent or eradicate the disease using two different tools:

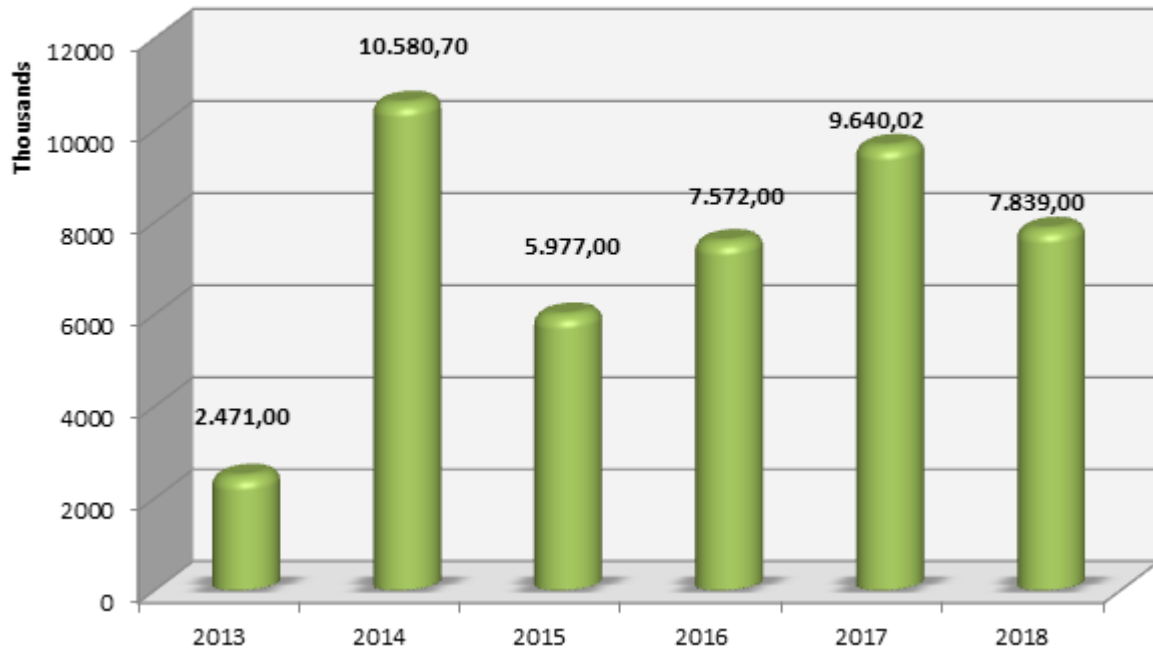
- emergency measures and
- eradication programmes

44 M EUR allocated for the period 2013-2018

Up to 75% co-funding rate for the reimbursement of the cost incurred

# EU funds allocated by the EU

**African swine fever: allocation / year**



- Maximum amount allocated in 2014 (first cases of ASF in EU)
- Steady increase in the allocation for 2015, 2016, 2017
- “false” decrease in 2018: outbreak control funded under emergency measures



## **EU financial support to the Member States:**

EU financial support is being granted to Member States:

- currently affected by the disease (Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic and Romania);
- not affected by the disease, but bordering non-EU countries that are infected (Germany, Finland and Slovakia).

# EU financial support to the Member States:

## Co-funded measures:

- Surveillance: sampling and testing of animals;
- awareness-raising campaigns;
- wild boar management measures, as targeted hunting to control populations and removal of dead wild boar from the environment to reduce the viral load;
- disinfection actions;
- other measures specific for each programme tailored to the Member State situation: laboratory equipment , vehicles etc.

Cost related to outbreak control are dealt by emergency measures



## EU financial support to non EU countries:

- EU financial support to Moldova and Ukraine started **in 2016** (lab support)
- **2017**: two pilot projects implemented
- **2018**: draft programmes under assessment
- Co-Funding rate 100%



# EU financial support to non EU countries-2017:

## ➤ For Ukraine:

- 225 000 EUR allocated
- Surveillance: testing and sampling
- In oblasts bordering the EU and Moldova

## ➤ For Moldova:

- 150 000 EUR allocated
- Purchase of material to control the disease
- In the whole country
