Distribution: The distribution frequency to kids depends on the internal organisation of each school. (For 2022-2023 the participating schools had selfreported that $35.29 \%$ would distribute milk/milk products on 1 day/week: $4.71 \%$ on 2 days/week: $16.47 \%$ on 3 days/week: $1.18 \%$ on 4 days/week: and 42.35\% on 5 days/week (a school week is equal to 5 days /week)) |
